

TIP-IN CLUB MEETING MINUTES
Held at Administration Building, Yukon, OK
Sunday, September 13, 2015

Meeting called to order by President Cheryl O'Bannon. Eight members attended. Also present were Coach Kevin Ritter and Coach Justin Raper.

- I. Welcome and Agenda Review: President Cheryl O'Bannon
- II. Yukon Tip-In Club Budget 2015-2016: Went over budget.
 - a. Member Tamara Berg made a motion for the Tip-In to pay for Crossover Film Service cost of \$2,200. Member Yuki Havern seconded. All members agreed.
 - b. Coach Justin Raper discussed training supply list needs. Cost will go down as Athletic Director Fisher has agreed to pay half of the cost. Motion to approve paying the cost for these supplies made by Member Tamara Berg and seconded by Member Julie Henry.
 - c. Going to book six rooms for Durant Tournament. Coach Kevin Ritter suggested buying snacks for players (allergies of some players should be considered).
 - d. Team meals suggested cost of \$50 per player.
 - e. Team apparel orders were charged high costs for shipping (each parent charged approximately \$33-\$40). Coach Kevin Ritter is going to check on getting a team credit for at least part of these charges.
 - f. Suggested having the players host a 2-day camp for young up-coming basketball players as a fundraiser titled Boys' Youth Basketball Clinic. Charge \$10 per child. Member Star Brazell is going to coordinate this. To be held on a Tuesday and Wednesday in September.
 - g. Coach Kevin Ritter suggested coming up with a way players can raise money for an incentive, such as a credit towards basketball apparel.
- III. Tip-In Club Website: Member Valorie Branstool has updated coaches' biographies on the website. Website is continuously being updated.
- IV. Upcoming Events: The following events were discussed:
 - a. Free-Throw Fundraiser: Kick-off (give to students) by October 1st. Money due date for Free-Throw Fundraiser will be November 15th. Forms are ready and will be posted on the website.
 - b. Czech Festival Basketball Float: Scheduled for October 3rd. Member Tamara Berg is ordering balls to be thrown out. Players must wear a red or white shirt.
 - c. Media Day: Tentatively scheduled at the high school November 3rd and middle school November 10th.
 - d. Basketball 101: Was originally scheduled for October 20th. This event is cancelled. Instead, going to draw up a "tip sheet" to hand out at parent night and put on the website.
 - e. Basketball Bash: Was originally scheduled for November 21st – reconsider new date because of conflict. New suggested first choice date will be Sunday, November 15th from 5pm-8pm. Second choice would be November 22nd. Meeting for committee for the bash meeting on September 20th at 2:30pm at Mazzios.
 - f. Scrimmage Updates: Member Valorie Branstool will update scrimmage dates as soon as she receives a list from Coach Kevin Ritter (hopefully this week).

- g. Parent Meeting: Tentatively scheduled for high school for September 29 at 6:30pm. Middle school will come up with their own parent meeting date in November after teams are chosen.
