Parents, coaches, and other adult influencers also play a vital part as role models and information sources for our kids, yet 85% of young people report that no parent, teacher, or coach has ever spoken to them about the dangers of anabolic steroids.



THF speaks to audiences across the country educating them about these dangerous drugs. Our core assembly program is called **HOOT'S CHALK TALK** and provides a very personal and captivating view into the illegal world of anabolic steroids and other APEDs. This one-hour assembly program has been created to raise awareness and provide education on the subject of the use of APEDs. Over 100,000 people have attended a HOOT'S CHALK TALK program.

The **Taylor Hooton Foundation** was formed in 2004 because a promising young athlete made an uneducated choice and became involved in taking anabolic steroids. This decision lead to his death; he committed suicide at the age of 17. Taylor nor his friends knew how dangerous these drugs could be. THF is the only entity - public or private - dedicated to providing education on this topic. We believe if Taylor had been exposed to a program like this, he would still be alive today.


