President: Funding Requests

Swimming: Parkas with custom Iron on patch in memory of Coach Booth who recently passed away in the amount of \$597.18. These are for the coaches, which helps supports comfortability and makes it easier for swimmers to identify their coaches on pool deck. Student/coaches have worked fireworks booth fundraiser. Request was sent through ASB first and their request was denied as their account is deficient. Ms. DeYoung also states swimming is willing to help, and support however they need and are asked to in future booster events. President David Vazquez praises swimming for checking all other resources before presenting to boosters. Brian Vazquez makes a motion to approve, Felix Cervantes 2nds the motion. No nays motion passes.

Soccer: Last year Clovis tournament soccer was approved dinner feed funds that ended up not being used as the restaurant comped the meal. Soccer wants to know if they can roll of the approval from last year (they forgot to put in the request prior to this year's tournament) to reimburse this years dinner in the amount of \$413.35. Boosters agreed we will not grant a roll over approval from last year. Instead, we will take this into consideration as new request for reimbursement of \$413.35. We will inform the coach to please remember protocol. Maria Quintero motions to approve the request, Sabrina Kau 2nd the motion. No nays motion approved. Reimbursement of \$413.35 to be issued.

New Business:

Seasonal Winter fundraiser – Pizza Factory Coupon for a dinner or Pizza Factory Discount Card. President David Vazquez to check on this. Boosters will stress to coaches and athletes that these tickets/discount cards have value and must understand they are liable for money. This fundraiser will run all of January to allow more time to sale these to maximize the profit.

Profits made off of this fundraiser will fund the banquet.

Additional Winter Fundraiser – 50/50 need not to be present raffle fundraiser. We've had success with 50/50 at the football games and are looking to try at all home sporting events during the winter season. Ticket price will be \$5 each and drawing will be at the winter sports banquet to capitalize on last minute ticket purchases from parents attending. Per the usual standard, must be 18 year or older to purchase, verification of identity for prize pick-up. Tickets to be designed and printed by Sabrina. Tickets to include numerical sequencing. Need to research into electronic payments so we can take advantage of the sales when buyer only has electronic payment. Goal is start selling as soon as next week.

Abraham and Claudia brought up the idea of doing concessions at the boys volleyball tournaments. They explained how they go to other tournaments at other schools and there is always a small concession stand and our tournament never seems to have. Discussed how we would have to check with Coach Sonia and see if this is something she is willing to allow us to handle the concessions during their tournaments.



Last item of new business – Boosters has offered spring sports if memberships purchased now they will receive a discount.

Athletics: Banquet last week of February 1st week of March. Discussion with boosters present, we agreed March 5th is the best day to hold banquet. We will relay the information to AD Vazzy to make sure gym is available.

Spring Banquet Tuesday 5/20 6-8:30

The banquets' menu will consist of the same as the Fall and Winter banquets: pizza, pasta, salad, dessert, and drinks.

50/50 raffle at the banquet only. Tickets will remain at \$5.

32 table covers were bought, totaling \$202. 32 more covers were purchased during the meeting, totaling 64 table covers.

An email will be sent out to members needing help with serving at the banquet.

Payment to District for Track and Field storage Conex Box update – Felix has emailed, called and left voicemails, and went down to the district office in person (the accountant handling this was not there) and has received no response in any of the above-mentioned forms of contact. We will continue to reach out to settle this payment.

Soccer Rings Update: Rings total cost is \$15,600. AD Vazzy was able to get the company to lower the price from \$21,800. The status of the booster account is \$9,350. We are still \$6,000 short and would completely empty the booster account. Soccer has been working on trying to get a few sponsorships to help alleviate the cost. Coach Gabe and booster board to meet at a later date to discuss sponsorships and ring payment. The board to update members after.

Rodeo application update – Application was submitted in March. A follow up email was sent during the meeting regarding the status. Booster is waiting for a response from Rodeo.

Fireworks confirmation – Our sellers permit is being submit. Discussions between Vazzy and Milton (TNT contact) continue regarding same type of booth across the street from us. Compass church will have the community event again, which means sales may be low similar to this year.

ASB Contract – Our contract with ASB has officially expired. Our goal is to have a new contract with ASB before the end of the school year. This way we can offer memberships at the beginning of the 2025-2026 school year. Boosters is looking at a new membership tier system. Members present have come up with the following system:

3 tier system

Lowest Tier White: Membership price \$75 includes - \$1 off entry fee to all home games. If the parking price stays at \$5 it will be free, if it goes up to \$10 parking will be discounted to \$5. Free Booster t-shirt and sticker.

Middle Tier Blue: Membership price is \$175 includes – discounted prices to all home games as follows: Adults will pay student prices. Free parking, booster t-shirt, sticker, hat or beanie, website acknowledgement, 1 free entry to the 50/50 raffle at the banquets, and a discounted price on lineup cards per sport/season of \$3 (original price \$6)

Top Tier Gold: Membership price is \$300 includes – Free entry to all home games (excluding CCS (playoffs), CIF (state), and tournaments (these are fundraisers for the teams)), Free parking, sticker, tshirt, hat or beanie, website acknowledgement, seat cushion, blanket, 2 free entry to the 50/50 raffle at the banquets, and free lineup cards per sport/season.

We will draw up a proposal for ASB and present it to them to vote on before the end of year. Proposal to hold fundraisers during sporting events (50/50 raffle, lineup card sales, etc.) will also be drawn up and presented.

Scholarships – We received a total of 10 applications this year. Applications were reviewed and scored. After discussion and voting, the winning applications for this year scholarships are applications 8 & 9, Jaime Lucas (application 8) and Davio Quintero



(Application 9). Sabrina will send a notification email to both recipients, congratulating them on being this year's recipients.

With Claudia and Abraham being late to the meeting, we circled back to board positions and asked if they were interested in any position open. Claudia doesn't mind helping with membership services, so long her position at work changes. We will follow up with Claudia next month to see if she will be able to help with membership services.
