Financial:

Outstanding commitments have all been paid (concession stand)
Volleyball – \$1,000 Paid
Cheer – \$1,000 Paid (Track meets)
Basketball – \$1,200 Paid (Girls/Boys split)

Also paid for \$600 advertisement on website, \$4K for Rank 1 program, \$238 Rick Signs, \$283 for Regional Track Meet meals, \$200 for State Track meal and \$73 to Coach Edney meal to welcome new baby.

Scholarships:

Daniel discussed that in order for students to be awarded a scholarship, the parents also need to be a BC Member and have paid membership fee OR paid for a reserved parking spot. There are also many opportunities for the members to get involved and offer help. BC will allocate \$5K for scholarships this year and we will meet at the end of this session to review the scholarships. The students will receive their scholarships at the awards banquet set for May 12th 2025.

Remaining Action Item: Look at revamping the scholarship process.

Rank 1 Program

Program is up and running and BC has funded the approved \$4K.

Storage building for Booster store

\$5K was approved to purchase a storage building to serve as the Booster Club store. Received approval from the school and the storage building (12' X 16') has been ordered totalling \$3,500. *Remaining Action Items:* Building installation and setup. BC had found an electrician to run the electrical. Bidding out A/C installation, insulation and sheetrock. Have reached out to a couple WO businesses to bid out as well.

Website -

\$600 was approved and spent to be a sponsor on the website.

Remaining Action Items: Need to get Daniel added as an administrator of the BC page so that we can post minutes and other BC information.

FCA Ad funding request

Due to the significant price increase of putting an ad for a graduating student in the FCA magazine, it has been decided that the BC will not fund this ad moving forward.

7 on 7 program:

Ludlow is wanting to build up this football program and attend some tournaments. The tournaments will require an overnight stay. Looking at maybe an air bnb for the stay and BC contributing a portion or all of the funding for the stay.

"Square"

Daniel discussed possibly setting up "Square" for a back door inventory system. Originally we had the bank that was supposed to be coming up with a solution for inventory but now we might look at benefits of both and see what we will implement in the future.
