

1 Minute Home Drill Team and Band set up12 Minutes Home Drill Team and Band Performance

1 Minute Clear field and teams return to the field for Second Half Kickoff

# TEAM GUIDELINES

### **DRESSING**

- Dressing Facilities are located on the South end of the field.
- Home Team (West Locker Room) and Visiting Team (East Locker Room)
- Reserved parking for team buses is in the parking lot just South of the Locker Rooms.
- This lot is accessible from Lyons School Rd through gates #9 and #10.

### **PRESSBOX**

- Home Team Coaches are in the Millard Roth Press Box, located on the West side of the stadium, and Home Team Video Personnel, one coach, and two students will film from the deck on the top level of the Millard Roth Press Box. Video Personnel on the Field will be located behind the Goal Post on the North End of the Stadium.
- Visiting Team Coaches are in the Visitors' Press Box, located on the East side of the stadium, Visiting Team Video Personnel, one coach, and two students will film from the deck of the Visitors' Side Press Box. Video Personnel on the Field will be located behind the Goal Post on the North End of the Stadium.
- Scouts are located on the South end of the Visitors' Press Box. Preference is given to Coaches that are scouting for a game within the next two weeks.
- Radio Station hookups are in the middle two rooms of the Visitors' Press Box.

### **DIRECTIONS**

- From I-45 take Louetta Rd. heading west until you reach Stuebner-Airline Rd.
- From 249 take Louetta Rd. heading east until you reach Stuebner-Airline Rd.
- From Beltway 8 take Stuebner-Airline Rd. heading north until you reach Louetta Rd.
- From 2920 take Stuebner-Airline Rd. heading south until you reach Louetta
   Rd
- Spectator Parking for Home School is on Lyons School Road
- Spectator Parking for Visiting School is on Stuebner-Airline Road

# BAND & DRILL TEAM GROUPS

### WHEN YOUR TEAM IS ON THE HOME SIDE

- Park buses in the designated area on Lyons School Road facing North.
- Park the equipment buses in the drop-off area between Activity Gate #2 and Gate #3 and unload them as directed by the stadium personnel at the gate.
- Performing groups can enter the stadium through Activity Gate #3 and enter
  the stands using the ramp on the north end of the home stands to enter the
  band and drill team section. There are 600 seats in the section; use the diagram
  to determine the layout. You will enter the track through Gate E.
- Props and front ensemble can enter through Gate #2 and enter the track through Gate B.
- Lyons School Rd. will be blocked off until all buses are loaded at the completion of the game.
- You must have appropriate school identification to gain access to announce and view the performance or video. Only students in uniform will be allowed on the field.
- You may use the area between Gate C and the 40/25 second play clock to warm up. You may move across to the other side to assemble and enter the field at the appropriate time.

### **VISITOR BAND & DRILL TEAM GROUPS**

- Park buses in the Klein High Bus Loop as directed by stadium staff.
- Equipment buses may back up near Activity Gate #13 to unload. **Do not block** the gate.
- Performing groups can enter the stadium through Activity Gate #13. Use the ramp on the south end of the visitor's stands to enter the band and drill team section. There are 600 seats in the section; use the diagram to determine the layout.
- You must have appropriate school identification to gain access to announce and view the performance or video. Only students in uniform will be allowed on the field.
- Access to the track and playing field is through the steps at the bottom of your section. You may use the area between Gate Q and the 40/25 second play clock to warm up.

# **EVACUATION PLAN**

### **EVACUATION PLAN**

In the event of lightning, the following procedure will be followed for band, cheer, drill, and ROTC.

- The stadium will be evacuated under the direction of the Klein ISD Athletic Department.
- If the school has buses present, they can return to them until an all-clear is given. Otherwise, performing groups on the **Home Side** will exit the stadium to the North via Gate A to the hallway between the Natatorium and Klein High Athletic Locker Rooms. **Visitor Side performers** will exit the stadium to the North via Gate Z and Gate 19 to the Klein High Gym lobby until an all-clear is given. All sponsors and directors will remain with their groups.
- All groups will leave the field once the evacuation directive has been given.
- Moving under the stands is not an option or a safe place.
- Student safety is of the utmost importance.

# STADIUM GUIDELINES

# **Everyone entering a Ticket or Pass Gate shall be screened by a security walkthrough.**

 Any bag or purse that sets off the alarm will be searched. The spectator shall open the bag and allow the stadium worker to look inside. Clear bags are are enforced.

# **Patrons entering Ticket or Pass Gates should NOT bring the following:**

- Prepared food or large quantities of food, except as needed for small children or medical purposes. Drinks in any container except as needed for small children.
- Weapons of any kind.
- Klein Memorial Stadium has a Clear Bag Policy detailed on page 16 of this packet.
- Students are not allowed to leave the stadium and return without prior approval from an Administrator. If approved, the student must be accompanied by a ticket-holding adult or an Administrator.

Smoking and/or Vaping is not allowed on school property, so permission to exit to smoke cannot be given. Students are not allowed to be in possession of tobacco products.

# Student groups in uniform and their sponsors should enter through the appropriate activity gate and arrive as a group.

- Only student groups in uniform can form spirit lines.
- Band and Drill Team Directors are limited to one video person, announcer, and staff member accompanying them to the press box. They must always have a District Stadium Pass.
- Band "Pit Crews" and Drill Team "Prop Pops" will enter the stadium with their student group through the appropriate gate. The "Pit Crews" and "Prop Pops" must be easily identifiable either by badge or t-shirt. After pre-game festivities and half-time performance, the "Pit Crews" and "Prop Pops" will sit in the stands in a general admission seat unless they have purchased a reserved seat.
- Designated parents, "Helmet Crew," will enter the stadium with their student group through the appropriate gate. The "Helmet Crew" must be easily identifiable either by badge or t-shirt. KMS Stadium pass must always be visible. After pre-game festivities and half-time performance, the "Helmet Crew" will sit in the stands in a general admission seat unless they have purchased a reserved seat.

# STADIUM GUIDELINES

### Klein ISD coaches shall have a Sideline Pass, Team Area Pass, or be in School Uniform.

 Passes can be requested from the Athletics Office at least 72 hours in advance at gamedayaccess@kleinisd.net

**Spectators are always expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship.** 

# **Signage**

• Approved campus signage may be placed exclusively on the lower railing in front of the **band, drill, and student** sections.

# **Spectators are NOT allowed to:**

- Cross over to the opposing side of the stadium,
- Re-enter the stadium once you have exited,
- Enter the playing area or track,
- Use a ticket for entry on the opposing side.

### In case of inclement weather:

- No refunds or exchanges
- If a lightening alert is announced, you will be asked to exit the stadium and return to your vehicle,
- Provide proof of original ticket for re-entry

There are no refunds or exchanges on tickets.

The District Athletic Office and School Administration must approve tailgating. Regulations will be sent once the event has been approved. Send requests to gamedayaccess@kleinisd.net.

# **PASSES**

### **PASS GATES**

- All concourse and field pass holders will enter through Gate 15 on the visitor side, just left of the ticket booth.
- Sideline pass holders will enter the field at Gate Q, just right of the stands.

## **GAME DAY PASSES**

 TASO, THSCA, THSADA, TGCA, and District passes will be accepted exclusively at the Concourse Pass Gate. For visitors, please use Gate 15, just left of the visitor side ticket booth.

### SIDELINE PASSES

As a guest of our stadium, we prioritize the safety of our athletes, staff, and pass holders. To ensure a smooth and safe experience, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Sideline Boundaries:
  - Photographers and sideline guests must avoid entering the restraining lines or the team area, which spans from the 20-yard line to the 20-yard line, during the game.
  - Stay behind the yellow line at all times to provide officials and players with the necessary space to move freely.
- Pass Requirements:
  - Only individuals with a valid sideline pass are permitted on the sidelines outside of the team area if not in uniform.
  - Those holding a sideline pass should remain on the designated side and not cross over to the opposing team's sideline.
- Conduct:
  - Photographers and sideline guests should refrain from interacting with officials.
  - Please avoid any actions that might distract players or coaches during the game.
- Field Restrictions:
  - No food, drinks, gum, or seeds are allowed in the playing field area.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping Klein Memorial Stadium a safe and enjoyable environment for everyone.

# **SCOUTING & MEDIA**

### **SCOUTING**

- Scouting is limited to the next opponent for each team, with a maximum of three (3) scouts per school.
- Please send a list of scouts to gamedayaccess@kleinisd.net by noon on Wednesday, the week of the contest to be added to the Will Call List.
   Scouts must check in at the Visitor side Box Office and enter through Gate 15 on the Visitor Side.

### **MEDIA CREDENTIAL REQUEST**

- All photographers must be approved by the coach of his or her school to be on the sideline.
- All media and/or photographer requests must be submitted before noon on Wednesday the week of the contest by emailing gamedayaccess@kleinisd.net.
- All media and/or photographers should enter through Gate 5 on the home side or Gate 15 on the visitor side.
- Media and/or photographers are restricted to the Sideline only and should follow the following guidelines:
  - Sideline Boundaries:
    - Photographers and sideline guests must avoid entering the restraining lines or the team area, which spans from the 20-yard line to the 20-yard line, during the game.
    - Stay behind the yellow line at all times to provide officials and players with the necessary space to move freely.
  - Pass Requirements:
    - Only individuals with a valid sideline pass are permitted on the sidelines outside of the team area if not in uniform.
    - Those holding a sideline pass should remain on the designated side and not cross over to the opposing team's sideline.
  - Conduct:
    - Photographers and sideline guests should refrain from interacting with officials.






