

#### **ATs - Concussions**

- I. Student education/awareness
- II. Any doubt, any observation of impact AT evaluates (at practice, home game, away game) Error on the side of caution
  - III. Sway Testing
- IV. Concussion protocol teacher parent communication
- V. Return to Play dictated by AT, Doc note required, process





#### ATs - Process & Communication

- I. Healthy Roster
- II. If a parent wants to challenge an assessment III. Importance of Orthopedic eval/clearance
- IV. Doctors notes required to return from concussion and COVID
  - V. Over communicate & collaborate





#### Mental Health & Character Building

- Mental Health Communication, Proactive activities, check-ins, safety Plans
- Do the right thing always or you won't when it is crunch time
- Inclusion, Life Lessons, emphasis on treating everyone with respect
- Teachable Moments are always opportunities you're either addressing it or allowing it
- No Place for Hate Zero Tolerance for Bullying, harassment, discrimination
- Impactful coaching lasts a lifetime not just in a season





#### **Code of Conduct**

- Link to Code of Conduct
- 365, 7 days a week, on or off school campus high expectations for athletes and representing more than just themselves
  - Signed off on during registration
  - Suspendable consequences are at least 1 loss of contest
    - Social Media uptick screen shots are real





#### Required Player Parent Handbook

- Customized for each team, but lots of department expectations
- Parent/Guardian & player MUST SIGN and return
- Won't issue uniform until it's signed and returned
- **High expectations** participation is a privilege Schedules and contact information should be as clear as possible





#### **Student Clearance**

Registration & Sports Physical on file to participate
Payment & signed handbook prior to uniform handout

# Eligibility

- Semester Eligibility can regain halfway through the season
- Code of Conduct
- Transfer Students
- 5 credited classes per semester
- Weekly Eligibility (next slide) Coach communicates with students Tuesday evening - Thursday finalized
- Attendance 4 or more unexcused
- Can't travel with a D (must come up 24 hours prior)
- Ultimately students responsibility; do not submit assignments late if possible
- Families Check grades early and often
- Late Work policy if they miss for athletics





# **Eligibility Continued**

- Weekly eligibility 1 F or more one week week of eligibility (Thur-Wed); locked in for CHSAA record at Thursday at 10am for one week
- Pulled Tuesday afternoon; communicated to students that evening - IC must reflect by Thursday 10am (student must communicate)
- 4 or more unexcused absences ineligible Thur-Wed (must be cleared up 24 hours prior)
- Students responsibility to communicate with office if grades/attendance comes up **BEFORE Thurs 10am**.
- Do not pressure teachers to change grades; empower students to take responsibility and have conversations around assignments/grades
- Now includes Advisory!





### **Parent Expectations**

- Let the coaches coach
- Positive communication during competition with coaches, officials, other parents, other teams/athletes
- Support your athletes communicating/advocating with the coach
- 24 hour communication rule with coach following competition
- Your students have committed, so help us hold them accountable to committing to the team; make the team a priority
- ADs will not meet about playing time or team placement
- Let coaches know how much you appreciate them!

### Officials Needed

- If you have any interest Let ADs know!
- Game Cancellations are possible but we will try to avoid
- Please treat our officials with respect and thank them if you get the chance. Keep it positive or don't say anything at all
  - Communicate in-game frustrations with Coach & AD
    - Postseason Officials Ranking/Feedback or CHSAA communication

### Playing Time/Team Placement

- Up to the coaching staff ADs will not meet with parents regarding playing time/level placement unless... The player has spoken to coach; Parent has spoken to coach
- EMPOWER your STUDENTS
- Communicate skills/abilities & areas to improve to get to their desired level
- Coaches meet with students who are cut, make time for students/parents who want clarification
- Varsity Letters team specific criteria generally, active during 75% of varsity competition; ends in good standing; postseason participation





#### Stadium & Gym Game Day Expectations

- Game Day Info Shared with coaches to pass along to parents
- Gate Fees Adults \$7; DHS Students \$1; Military/Senior Citizens, other students \$5; 7-younger free
- Season Pass available for all regular season games \$80
- Entrance for Stadium through the building - no side gate access
- Bag Search





#### **Attendance at Practice & Cuts**

- Practice is required to be a part of the team
- High Expectations for our athletes time management is a life-skill
  - Early communication from the student to coaches
     Check sport specific handbooks
  - Club sport and in-season agreements season requires
     >75% attendance must sign CHSAA paperwork before games begin
    - Volleyball, Basketball, Baseball, B&G Soccer will have tryouts this year, cuts are possible



#### **Travel**

- High expectations of students while traveling coaches have a checklist for hotel supervision and protocols; searching bags, bed checks -CONSEQUENCES if handbook/code of conduct is broken while on the road
- Contacting local police & parent/guardian responsibility to pick the student up immediately
- <u>Parent Transportation waiver</u>- or parents sign out w/ coach





# Weekly Communications/Parent

Meeting

- Coaches host a pre-season meeting
- Team expectations/Handbook
- Methods of communications explained
- Answer questions and concerns
- Weekly communication during season
- NO SOCIAL MEDIA TEAM COMMUNICATION





#### **Budget**

- Budget covers transportation, coach stipends, payroll taxes, fees, officials, uniforms, ATs, facilities...
- Fundraising covers all items that students keep gear, food, awards, specialist coaches





### **Parent Support**

- Assist in meals, logistics and communication
  - Proactive communication check IC Often!
