Game Location: All games will be played at Charleston High School's Baker and TBA. If it is cool enough, we will play games in the High School Auxiliary Gym. If it is too hot, we will play in the Jefferson Elementary gym. I will let everyone know the location on Tuesday, Sept. 15. Volleyballs will be provided for warm up.

Fan Parking and Gym Entrance: Team buses should unload at the main entrance of Baker Gymnasium (south side of CHS) or the east entrance of Jefferson Elementary School. Buses may park in the lot on the north side of the high school (access available from Lincoln Avenue) or the lot on the west side of Jefferson Elementary. Fan parking will be available on the south, east, and north sides of Charleston High School and East Side of Jefferson Elementary.

Teams will have a locker room or classroom space available to wait between matches.

Warmups: The first game of the tournament will be 2-6-6. All other warmups will be 2-3-3

All Matches: **2 out of 3 to 25 no cap, 3rd game to 15 no cap**

The first team listed will be the home team.
