COVID-19 SUMMER PLAN 2020

Our plan is for coaches to have face-to-face contact with athletes using the provisions below. Phase 1 will begin June 1, 2020. Phase 1 will include Summer Pride and Open Gym/Turf Time for Secondary Athletes Only.

We will revisit and adjust (if needed) when Phase 2 will begin and what will be allowed. At this time Phase 2 will start June 15, 2020. Phase 2 is a continuation of Phase 1 with addition of Try-Outs, Camps, Intersquad Scrimmage and Games vs. other schools.

PHASE 1 JUNE 1, 2020

On June 1, 2020 we will begin summer activities.

1. Each person entering the facility **MUST** have completed the COVID-19 Screening and answered no to all questions before being allowed to enter. Any individual with a temperature registering **100.4** degrees or above **WILL NOT** be permitted to stay. COVID-19 Screening must be signed and dated by the parent, guardian or coach.
 - a. Any person (coach or athlete) who has had a temperature registering **100.4** degrees or above upon arriving at our facilities **MUST** have a release from a MD or a DO before they will be allowed to come back to our facilities.
 - b. A person testing positive for COVID-19 cannot return to any of our facilities until they can show that they have tested negative 2 times.
 - c. If anyone tests positive for COVID-19 then the facility the person has been at will be closed for 2 days for deep cleaning.
2. Hands **MUST** be washed or hand sanitizer used prior to entering the facility and touching any equipment. Coaches will have hand sanitizer available.
3. Mask are optional
4. Social distancing is a **MUST** and there should be **NO BODY** contact between athletes.
5. No shared hydrating bottles, towels, gloves, weight belts or any other personal equipment is permitted.
6. All equipment **WILL** be sanitized after summer pride or open gym/turf is finished for the day.

This packet includes the COVID-19 Screening Test.

Parents can complete the COVID-19 Screening Test at home and send it with their athlete.

When we have enough Thermometers, if a parent doesn't fill out the form then a coach will fill out and sign the form when the student arrives.

The COVID-19 Screening must be completed each and every time anybody enters our facility.
