PLAYER CONTRACT

I _____ agree to abide by the following rules and guidelines in order to be a participant in the basketball program.

Expectations as a Student

1. I will maintain an 80 or better in all classes and a satisfactory in conduct. If I fall below these expectations I will be required to attend tutorials twice a week in that subject until my grade is acceptable with team guidelines.
2. I will be respectful and behave appropriately in the classroom and during transitions between classes.
3. I will not be placed in detention, I.S.S, or any disciplinary programs.
4. I will not post inappropriate material on social media. Such as: about drugs, alcohol, sex, race, teammates, school sports programs, school, teachers, etc.

Attendance

1. I understand that the athletic period is not a choice and is not to be skipped or used as a tutorial period for other classes.
2. I understand that practice is NOT optional. My attendance is mandatory unless prior excuse from a coach and/or a documented approved illness or emergency.
3. I will be on time and prepared to work each and every day in approved attire established by the coaching staff.

Practice/Games:

1. All student/athletes involved in the Boys Basketball Program will ride the bus to and from all games and events that are scheduled. Only exception is a family emergency. All proper paperwork must be filled out before student leaves with his parents.
2. I will avoid negative comments about any teammates. I will speak positively about the program and motivate my peers.
3. I will accept responsibility for my actions.
4. I will accept all disciplinary actions from the coaching staff for receiving technical fouls. If a player begins to consistently receive technical fouls, coaching staff will convene and decide the proper discipline. Ex. Multiple days of running, suspension from games, suspension indefinitely, and/or removal from the program.
5. I will not be detrimental to the team, program, or school. My behavior in practice, games, schools, and public will follow the discipline guidelines outlined by the coaching staff.

Dress Code:

1. I will wear appropriate Brazoswood attire at games and practice.
2. I will abide by the school dress code at all times.
3. I will wear dress shirt, tie, slacks, and dress shoes on game days; unless told otherwise.

Team Captains:

1. I will set a positive example for the team by following the rules and philosophy outlined by the coaching staff.
2. I will promote and demonstrate team unity.
3. I will be the first source of contact if problems or concerns arise on the team.
4. I will communicate effectively with coaching staff and my teammates regarding questions, concerns, ideas, and needs

Injuries:

1. I will immediately notify a coach when I'm injured in practice or games.
2. I will see the trainer for evaluation before seeing a physician.
3. I will follow the regime as outlined by the trainer for all injuries.
4. I will communicate with the coaches and trainers on the status of any injuries. For example, you twist your ankle in practice and go to the trainer for treatment. A week later your ankle worsens. This needs to be reported to the coaches and trainer immediately.

Locker-room and Equipment Maintenance:

1. I will return all equipment issued clean and in good condition
2. I will keep my practice and game clothes clean and in good condition throughout the season.
3. I will keep the locker-room clean at ALL times.
4. I will lock my personal items away EVERYDAY.

Community Service:

1. I will be involved in all community service projects outlined by the coaching staff, to receive service hours that will help with my resume and college application.
