# League of Legends



- 5 player team + 1 alternate. Need a top, jungle, mid, bot, and support.
- Competes on Tuesdays, team practice on Monday.
- 1 game competitions
- **NO TOXIC BEHAVIOR ALLOWED**
- No try out needed, based on ranking. Player history.



# Rocket League



- 3 player team, 1 alternate.
- 3 v 3 Soccer mode, no bots, DFH Stadium, 5 min matches. Best of 3 games.
- Competes on Thursdays, team practice on Wednesday.
- No Tryouts unless A and B team needed.
  - Round 1: Based on ranking.
  - Round 2: 3 v 3 matches.



# Smash Ultimate



- 3 player team, 1 alternate.
- Will have A and B team.
- 1 v 1. No items
- Battlefield, Final Destination, Pokémon Stadium 2, Town & City, and Smashville.
- Competes on Wednesday, team practice online Mondays.
- Tryouts: Double elimination tournament. Top 8: 2 teams of 3, 2 alt.

# Splatoon 3



- 4 vs 4
- **Best-of-5 Games:** The first team to win 3 out of 5 games will win the match. Any remaining games in the series will not need to be played.
- **Game Mode Order**
  - Game 1 - Turf War
  - Game 2 - Splat Zones
  - Game 3 - Tower Control
  - Game 4 –
  - Game 5 – Clam Blitz
- **Weapons/Gear:** Anything a player has unlocked may be used, except that Splatfest Tees are not allowed to be worn.
- Practice Monday, Compete Tuesday



- 4 player team + 1 alternate.
- Best of 3 Team series consisting of 6 races per game. 4v4 format.
- Each player's points on the team will contribute to the team's overall total points
- 150cc Race, Team Game mode, Normal Items, No Computer players, Random tracks,
- All Kart settings and Racers allowed
- Competes on Thursdays, team practice on Tuesdays online.
- Tryouts
  - Round 1: Time trials on 4 chosen tracks.
  - Round 2: 2 vs 2 on teams.

We will have a fundraiser option this year to earn your fees.

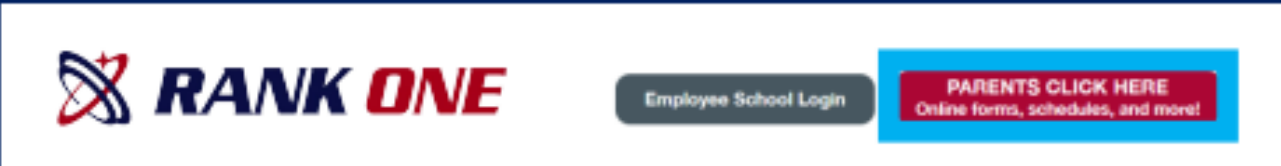
