These rules/guidelines are set up in the best interest of the athlete and Chattahoochee Athletics. It is the objective of Chattahoochee Athletics to demonstrate Pride, Respect, and Integrity while representing Hooch Athletics in any capacity. This will help to develop strong characteristics in life as they prepare for their future. With these thoughts in mind, strong guidelines must be observed so that these values may be taught through athletics.

The following violations may be cause for conference (player and/or parent), suspension, and/or dismissal from the team. Each case will be evaluated on an individual basis. All decisions by the coach, school administration, and/or athletic director are final.

- Use of <u>illegal drugs or alcohol</u> (County mandated suspension: 20% of season 1st offense, 50% 2nd offense, full suspension for 1 calendar year on 3rd offense). See Fulton County Student Athlete Handbook for specific sport breakdowns.
- 2. Use of <u>tobacco</u> (County mandated suspension: 10% of season 1st offense, 50% on 2nd offense, full suspension for 1 calendar year on 3rd offense). See Fulton County Student Athlete Handbook for specific sport breakdowns.
- 3. <u>Missing practice</u> (unless excused by the coach).
- 4. <u>Skipping school or classes</u> attendance rules do apply for athletic participation 4 or more periods must be attended.
- 5. Acting in an <u>unsportsmanlike manner</u> while representing Chattahoochee.
- 6. Violating team curfew.
- 7. Any act at school or away from school that, in the opinion of the coaches and school administration, reflects in a negative manner on the athletic program (Social Media*).

*Monitor your social media/cell phone activity. A good rule of thumb is to assume that the administration, your parents, and the coaching staff are reading and viewing everything you post. If this would alter what you post, then you probably shouldn't post it, text it, Tweet it, Instagram it, etc..
