Behavior Expectations for Student Groups

- Always provide positive support for your team. Never ridicule or degrade the opposing team or players.
- Conduct yourself in an exemplary manner. Remember that you represent your school both at home and away.
- Assist cheerleaders with yells, chants, etc. Always be a working part of pep assemblies with preparation, organization and involvement.
- Treat opposing players, coaches, spectators and support groups with respect and enthusiasm. Applaud good performances on both teams. Doing this will show that you understand and can recognize good performance, regardless of team affiliation.
- Always display proper sportsmanship toward officials and value their contributions to the game. Respect the judgments made during a contest. All calls are impartial and should be accepted by all parties.
- Use only positive cheers, signs and chants during a contest. This will show that you understand proper sportsmanship while giving your organization and school a good reputation.
- Please leave backpacks at home or in your vehicles as it leads to congestions in the stands.
- No student Prek – 8th grade will be allowed at an event without being accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Each event will have an identified student section. Students must sit in the designated area unless seated with a responsible adult.
- Students will remain in their seats at athletic events unless using the restroom or visiting a concession stand. Students will not loiter in common areas, and will be asked to leave if that becomes a problem.
- Students are required to leave the premises of the event within 20 minutes of the close of the activity. An official count down timer will be displayed on the scoreboard at each event. Failure to leave the premises may include follow up discipline at the campus level, as well as removal from future school sponsored events.
- Students are expected to show positive Pirate Pride and support the extracurricular event in an appropriate manner. Students who refuse to follow the direction of staff members, try to run away from authority, become rowdy, or are disrespectful to spectators will be removed from the event. Consequences may include follow up discipline at the campus level, as well as removal from future school sponsored events.
