

Bryan Viking Football Tickets 2020

Dear Friday Night Viking Parents,

We hope everyone is doing well and thank everyone for the patience and loyalty for the Viking season. As a result of COVID-19, we are suspending season tickets for the 2020 season. We plan to resume season tickets in 2021 as normal. With social distancing requirements, capacity will be limited at all athletic events. Merrill Green Stadium's capacity will be approximately 25%. As we made plans for attendance at varsity football, we outlined our goals.

1. Be responsible to this community and develop a plan that focuses on the health and safety of the members of our community.
2. Ensure parents of participants have the first opportunity to purchase tickets.

This year we will sell tickets in pods of four seats for \$20. This will allow us to limit capacity along with social distancing guidelines. All tickets will go on sale to the public starting Tuesday the week of a home game starting at 1:00 pm. Parents of Friday night participants get the chance to purchase ONE pod prior to public sales. Starting Monday 8:00 am through Tuesday at noon each week of a home event. Parents of participants will use their student's ID number as a "promo" code to purchase their one pod. Once public sales begin, parents can purchase more pod(s).

We are excited to announce that this year we are broadcasting all home games! You can access this through the "broadcasting" tab on our website. With a subscription, you will be able to watch all home games at Merrill Green Stadium, our BHS Main gym, Baseball and Softball games too.

Merrill Green Stadium Protocols for 2020:

- All guests must undergo a COVID – 19 screening prior to entrance.
- All guests must wear a mask or facial covering to enter the stadium and keep it on. Refusal will result in removal from the facility. Masks must be of a solid fabric.
- All spectators must comply with Executive Order GA-29 regarding face coverings and all other mandates and UIL/TEA policies.
- No unattended children, grades 8 or below will be allowed into the stadium. They must attend and sit with a parent/guardian.
- No passes will be accepted at the gate (including but not limited to District passes, THSCA).
