

Athletic Training Staff,

Please see the information below outlining the resources and important information available to your team during varsity and sub-varsity games at Huntsville ISD Hornet Stadium.

Field Set-Up and Resources:

- **Water Access:** Sideline continuous cow at the 50-yard line.
- **Injury Supplies:** A chest with injury ice and bags.
- **Extreme Heat Provisions:** Our rapid cooling station is located inside the Athletic Training Clinic connected to the stadium.
- **Where to park:** Bus parking is located at Huntsville High School's main campus. Access Hornet Way from FM 2821 Rd E and follow the road to the designated bus parking area.
- **AED:** The primary AED is located on the home side. The secondary AED is located in the hallway to the Field House connected to the stadium.

Additional Medical Coverage (Varsity Only):

- Walker County EMS on standby.
- Team Physician/Fellow present on home side.

Medical Time Out (Varsity Only):

- At 6:30 PM on the track near the field entrance to the Field House.
- Attendees:
 - Home and Visiting Athletic Trainer
 - EMS personnel
 - Home and visiting administrator/principal on duty
 - Home and visiting coaching representative
 - Home and visiting sideline official

Emergency Medical Information:

For injuries requiring ambulance transport that are not considered critical or do not require a higher level of care, patients will typically be transported to Huntsville Memorial Hospital. More serious or critical injuries may require transport to HCA Conroe or Memorial Hermann - The Woodlands, but this decision remains fluid depending on the severity of the situation. In the event that air medical transport is necessary, the patient may be flown to Texas Medical Center, although this is unlikely.

If a minor athlete is transported and a parent/guardian is not present, Walker County EMS asks that a school representative remain with them until a parent/guardian can be present. Please be able to provide athlete demographic information, medications, allergies, etc upon request.

For minor, stable injuries, we coordinate with the coaches to confirm whether a parent/guardian is present and able to transport the athlete. In such cases, we recommend urgent care clinics, with Texpress Urgent Care being the closest option. Hours of operation are M-F, 8:00 AM–7:00 PM, and Sat/Sun, 10:00 AM–5:00 PM. Therefore, this option will typically only be available during sub-varsity competitions.

- Huntsville Memorial Hospital (Level IV trauma facility) - 110 Memorial Hospital Dr., Huntsville, TX 77340
 - 8 miles away and roughly 15-20 mins by car
- HCA Conroe (Level II trauma facility) - 504 Medical Center Blvd, Conroe, TX 77304
 - 34 miles away and roughly 35-40 mins by car
- Memorial Hermann The Woodlands Medical Center (Level II trauma facility) - 9250 Pinecroft Dr., The Woodlands, TX 77380
 - 41.3 miles away and roughly 40-50 minutes by car
- Texas Medical Center (Level I trauma center) - 6550 Bertner Ave, Houston, TX 77030
 - 76 miles away and roughly 1.5 hours by car
