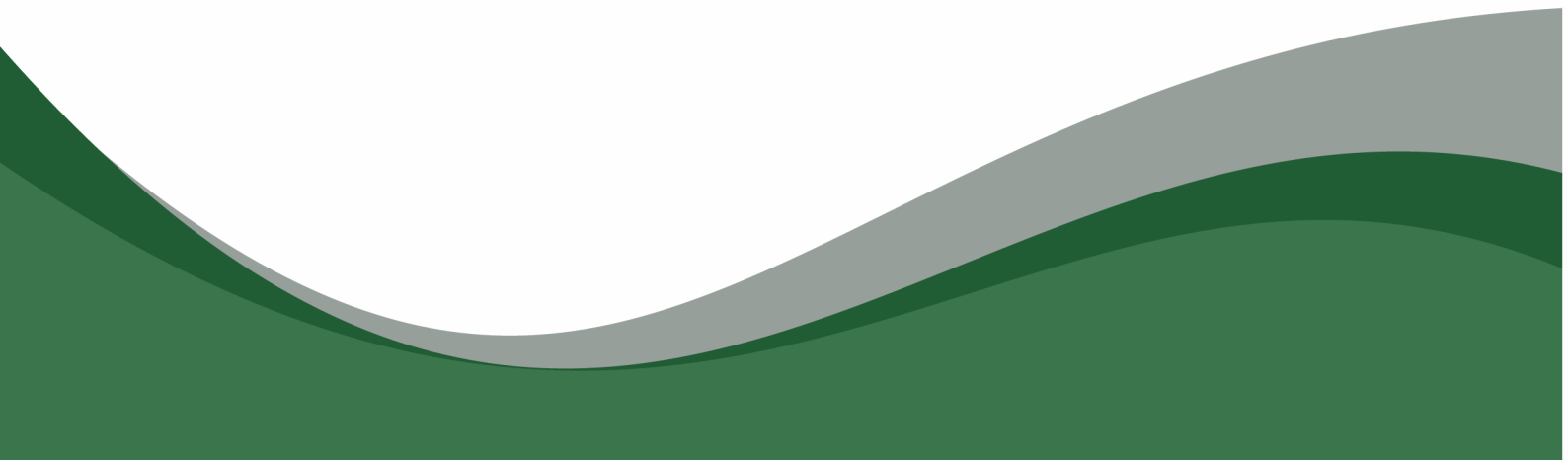

- AREA MEET DIRECTORS, PLEASE SUBMIT A COPY OF YOUR AREA MEET RESULTS VIA EMAIL TO CODY HASSELL AT CWHASSELL@HUNTSVILLE-ISD.ORG. THIS YEAR ALL AREA MEETS WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY LOADED BY MILESPLIT INTO THE REGIONAL MEET. WE WILL ONLY USE THESE AS A BACKUP IN THE EVENT THAT THERE ARE ANY ERRORS.
- ANY SCRATCHES AND/OR ADDITIONS **MUST BE CERTIFIED BY AREA /DISTRICT MEET DIRECTOR**. THE COACH SCRATCHING AN ATHLETE SHOULD CONTACT THE AREA DIRECTOR AND THE NEXT PLACE COACH. THE AREA DIRECTOR SHOULD VERIFY WITH THE NEXT PLACE COACH IF THAT ATHLETE WILL INDEED PARTICIPATE. ONCE VERIFIED, THE **AREA DIRECTOR** SHOULD CONTACT THE HUNTSVILLE ISD ATHLETIC OFFICE (936.435.6135). PLEASE SUBMIT THE SAME INFORMATION VIA EMAIL TO: CODY HASSELL, CWHASSELL@HUNTSVILLE-ISD.ORG.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

CERTIFICATION:

ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THE UIL REGIONAL TRACK & FIELD MEET MUST BE CERTIFIED BY THEIR AREA MEET DIRECTOR. THE COMPLETE SET OF RESULTS MUST BE SENT TO THE HUNTSVILLE ISD ATHLETIC OFFICE: ATTENTION CODY HASSELL

QUALIFIERS WHO CANNOT COMPETE

A COACH WHO HAS A QUALIFIER WHO CANNOT COMPETE IN THE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP MEET MUST CONTACT THE DIRECTOR OF HIS/HER AREA MEET NO LATER THAN **TUESDAY, APRIL 28, BEFORE 10:00 AM**. IT IS ALSO THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COACH TO CONTACT THE COACH OF THE NEW ALTERNATE AND INFORM THEM OF THE OPEN POSITION.

ALTERNATES WHO MOVE INTO QUALIFYING POSITIONS

COACHES OF ALTERNATES WHO HAVE BEEN MOVED UP TO QUALIFYING POSITIONS MUST CALL THE DIRECTOR OF THE **AREA MEET** TO DECLARE THAT THEIR ATHLETE WILL COMPETE.

FINAL ENTRY CONFIRMATION PROCEDURES

FINAL CHANGES DUE TO AREA MEET DIRECTORS - TUESDAY, APRIL 28, AT 10:00 AM.

THE DIRECTOR OF THE DISTRICT/AREA MEET MUST EMAIL OR CALL THE HUNTSVILLE ISD ATHLETIC OFFICE BETWEEN 8:00 AM AND NOON ON TUESDAY, APRIL 28TH TO MAKE FINAL DECLARATIONS OF ALL ENTRIES FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE DISTRICT/AREA. **THE DISTRICT OR AREA MEET DIRECTOR MUST CONFIRM ALL ENTRIES EVEN IF THERE ARE NO CHANGES**. ANY CHANGES IN QUALIFIERS ON THE OFFICIAL ENTRY LIST WILL BE MADE AT THIS TIME. INDIVIDUAL COACHES, PLEASE DO NOT CALL IN ANY CHANGES. CHANGES CAN ONLY BE MADE BY THE DISTRICT/AREA MEET DIRECTOR. IT IS THE COACH'S RESPONSIBILITY TO INFORM THE DISTRICT/AREA MEET DIRECTOR OF ANY CHANGES DUE TO INELIGIBILITY, INJURY, ETC.



PARKING - TEAM ENTRANCE AND SET-UP

COACH, TRAINER, PARTICIPANT ENTRANCE

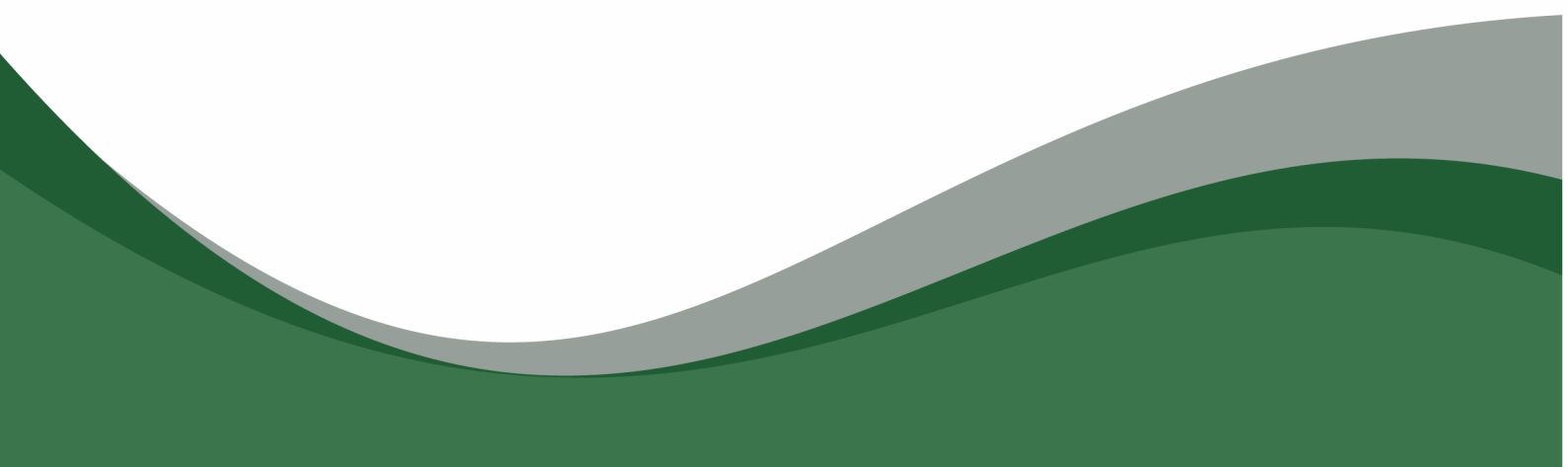
- Each competing team will receive 4 wristbands for coaches and/or trainers. Please contact Cody Hassell if you need additional wristbands. Participants will enter near the HHS Fieldhouse on Friday and through the VISITORS ENTRANCE GATE on Saturday, which is located behind the tennis courts, adjacent to the high school.

TEAM PACKETS

Team packets can be picked up at the Huntsville Fieldhouse, 2nd level - access the outside stairs facing the parking lot.

Packet Pick-up: Thursday, April 30 from 4:30 pm - 6:30 pm

Remaining packets will be distributed at the coaches meeting with the Meet Referee at 8:00 AM on Friday in the same location.



UIL MEET RULES

- The first and second place finishers in each event qualify for the State Meet.
- Coaches will not be allowed on the track.
- Contestants must report on time to be entered in any event. Any contestant who fails for any reason to be on hand at the time of preliminaries shall forfeit the right to compete in the preliminaries and finals of the event (UIL PLAN SECTION 1320-J)
- No excuse will be accepted for failure of a team or contestant who does not appear at the announced reporting time.
- Lane assignments will be based on results from the Area Meet qualifying times.

ATHLETE CHECK IN:

When athletes present themselves to the clerk for check-in they must be run ready. A complete uniform must be on their body with the number attached to their uniform top. Relay team uniforms (shirt and shorts) must be identical.

VIDEO TAPING

Athletes and coaches may utilize electronic devices to aid in the athlete's performance. Usage of such devices may not slow down or interfere with the normal flow of the meet or be used for protest.


Athletes are not permitted to wear any type of audio-video device to record or transmit a race or trial. This includes headphones, smart watches, and sunglasses with recording capabilities that will not be permitted in restricted areas. Wearing of these devices during an event will result in a disqualification.

WEATHER

We do not anticipate any bad weather; however, we must plan for it. All spectators will go below the Home Side Stands or to their vehicles. Athletes will gather and be escorted to the Paul Bohan Gym Bleachers. Updates will be broadcast by the Stadium Announcer and sent to coaches via SportsYou. The SportsYou code is: **GWWS-J6N6**

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN

Implement weigh-in for discus and shot put and the athlete weigh-in for pole vault will be from 7:15 AM to 8:15 AM on the 2nd floor of the Huntsville ISD Field House on the respective day of their events. All implements will be checked in and measured. Legal implements will be marked and ushered to the proper circle by an official before the start of warm-ups. Implements that do not weigh in will be impounded. After the competition is over, it is the athlete's responsibility to check out their implements from an official. Legal implements will be checked back out to the athlete or a school official at the location of the event. Please follow the weigh-in schedule to prevent any delays.



RESULTS SHEETS

Results and qualifiers for all events will be posted as soon as they are available on tx.milesplit.com. Live results are available via www.tx.milesplit.com.

ACCESS TO TRACK

Officials will escort competitors to the track prior to each race, as well as to the exit gate upon completion of each race. Access will be allowed only through the Starting Clerk Gate. Athletes **MUST** check in with the clerk in the clerking area before they will be allowed on the track.

PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in writing from the school's Head Track Coach to the designated official at the starting clerk tent or in the press box within thirty (30) minutes of the results being posted. The designee will notify the meet referee.

PROPOSED OPENING HEIGHTS AND INCREMENTS

Opening heights are based on the AREA RESULTS.

The Pole Vault will progress at 6" increments, The High Jump will progress at 2" increments. When four jumpers are left, the pole vault will progress at 3" increments. The high jump will progress in 1" increments.

HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL JUMPS

Ties in High Jump and Pole Vault - any tie that involves places 1st - 6th will be required to compete in a tie breaker. All tiebreakers will take place once the competition is completed (it is the responsibility of the athletes and coaches to be present; an announcement will be made once the competition is completed).

Long Jump, Triple Jump, and Pole Vault - athletes are not permitted to run backward on the runway before, during, or after the competition.

RELAY PRACTICE TIME

The track will be open at the following times for relay practice:

- Friday 1:00 pm - 2:50 pm
- Saturday 1:00 pm - 2:50 pm

RELAY CARDS WITH ATHLETES' NAMES MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE STARTING CLERK TENT ONE HOUR BEFORE THE RACE.

SEEDING/LANE ASSIGNMENTS:

- Heats will be seeded according to the AREA TIME, but lanes will be random within the heats. Finals will be seeded based on prelim times in standard lanes. AREA MEET DIRECTORS will need to send a copy of their meet results to Cody Hassell: cwhassell@huntsville-isd.org.

AWARD PRESENTATIONS

Awards for all event finals will be given out immediately after the event is completed. The top three finishers will be escorted to the awards stand. We will not delay awards ceremonies if athletes do not show up and awards will not be mailed.
