Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the sidelines or in the end zones. All non-uniformed personnel will be required to display a pass for admittance to the field.

No Spectators will be allowed on the field following the game.

# STADIUM FOOTBALL INFORMATION REQUST FROM HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

- 5. Copy of Sideline Pass

### **HUNTSVILLE ISD STADIUM AND SPORTS COMPLEX POLICY:**

Note: Failure to comply with these rules will result in removal from the stadium

- Due to safety concerns, there will be limited re-entry into the stadium, sports complex and gyms during games. Students will NOT be allowed to leave and reenter at all. Adults may be allowed to leave and re-enter in special circumstances, but they need to make sure they keep their tickets, that they check with the gate attendee first to make sure it is okay, and that they leave and re-enter through the same gate.
- No outside food or beverages.
- State law and school district policies prohibit alcoholic beverages, use of tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes or any other electronic vaporizing device and controlled substance.
- Firearms are not allowed
- Confetti, balloons, glitter, or similar items requiring detailed clean-up are not permitted in the stadium.
- No unapproved sound systems will be allowed into the stadium.
- No loitering in or around the sport complex, stadium, gym
- No soliciting allowed. School sponsored organizations may gain approval from the Athletic Department for school approved fundraisers.
- Spectators sit in seats and off the rails, aisles to be kept clear at all times, no crossing over to the other side of stadium.
- Students (Pre-Kindergarten through Sixth grade must be accompanied by a parent or adult guardian, or they will not be admitted into the stadium.
- Parents or adult guardians are responsible for PreK-6th grade students' behavior and are responsible for their supervision during the event.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the stadium and return once the game has started.
- Only emergency vehicles may be parked near the North Entrance of Stadium. No vehicles of any kind are allowed to drive on the field surface, including trailers and golf carts.
- Victory lines shall be limited to sport team, drill teams and cheerleaders only.
- Following the game, spectators are not allowed on the track or turf.
- Only credentialed authorized personnel will be allowed on the field or in the press box area before the game, at halftime, or after the game. Individuals on the field or surrounding area must present a sidelines pass. Each school is responsible for their sideline.
- The Student Handbook and Code of Conduct will be in effect for all HISD students attending stadium, sports complex, and gym events. This means students may face additional disciplinary consequences at school.

### **HUNTSVILLE ISD FOOTBALL GAME DAY STADIUM GUIDELINES**

1. UIL, 10-5A or 16-5A policies will be strictly enforced.

### 2. MEDICAL:

- a. Medical emergencies at the Huntsville ISD Stadiums varsity football games will be handled by emergency crews from the Huntsville EMS.
- 3. **LIGHTNING PROCEDURE** Please follow the prompts on the PA and video board:
  - a. Spectators
    - i. Stadium Exit to your cars or under bleachers
  - b. Participants -
- i. Band Proceed to your buses
- ii. Athletics Proceed to the locker rooms
- iii Cheerleaders/Dance Squad-Proceed to your buses
- iv Home band / dance/ cheer exit to HHS Gym or Commons area

### 4. PRESS / MEDIA

- a. Only authorized news media and authorized photographers (student and adult) will be allowed on the field or in the team area before the game, during the game, during halftime and after the game.
- b. Radio, TV and authorized media personnel must fill out our Athletic Media Credential request at this link: Media Policy Must Complete

  This form must be completed by Wednesday at NOON of game week in order to receive a media pass for the press box or sideline.

### 5. SPIRIT, BAND and DANCE

- a. All bands, dance teams and cheer teams should park their buses in the along Hornet Way and enter on the Southeast side of the stadium. \*see dotted line on map
- b. Band and dance team directors and chaperones must wear identifying badges, enter with their groups and sit in section reserved for them. All bus drivers should also wear identification badges.
- c. Each school will be allowed a total of fourteen (14) minutes for the half-time performances.
- d. Arrangement for half-time refreshments is the responsibility of each group. Empty cans/bottles must be removed by the group responsible.
- e. The field is covered with artificial surface. Pointed objects or objects with sharp or uneven edges are prohibited on the field. This includes any props used by a band or drill team. Sidelines are to be kept free of any type of equipment that might injure an athlete as he goes out of bounds.
- f. No items of any kind are allowed to be thrown from the field into the stands without prior approval of the athletic department. Please send all requests to Lisa Blackburn via email at Iblackburn@huntsville-isd.org by Wednesday at NOON of game week.
- g. Live animal mascots are not allowed in the stadium. Dummy mascots, signs, etc., may not be paraded or displayed in the end zones or in front of the opponent's stands.

- h. NO band, dance team, cheerleaders or photographer may encroach upon the restraining lines (dotted line) or the bench area (20-yard line to 20-yard line) during the course of the game.
- i. Spirit Signs are allowed on the fencing and railing at the stadium. No sign or banner advertising businesses are allowed without the approval of the Athletic Director zip ties are required to hang spirit signs (NO DUCT TAPE). All signs and zip ties must be removed at the conclusion of the contest.
- **6. SIDELINE AND SIDELINE PASSES**: Only Authorized Personnel will be allowed on the field or in the fieldhouse area before the game, at half-time, and after the game. Individuals on the field must present their sideline pass HISD has provided.
  - a. You must present a school sideline pass All personnel on the sidelines who are not uniformed participants must have a "school sideline pass" attached to their clothing that will be visible to Huntsville Police and School Administrators on duty.
  - b. Teams coming to play at Huntsville ISD Stadium are to provide a copy of their sideline passes to the Athletic Department by Wednesday prior to Varsity Football Game
  - c. Photographers and news outlet personnel are restricted from entering the coach's box (25 yard line to 25 yard line).
  - d. No one is allowed to stand, photograph, or film from the end zone area of the field without authorization.
  - e. Please be aware of the sideline cameras as not to block the shot of the cameras.
  - f. Only dance teams, band students, or cheerleaders in uniform, may form spirit lines on the playing field.
  - g. Run-through signs may not be placed on the field if it has been raining and acrylic type paint has been used.
  - h. Glitter is not allowed to be used on any run-through signs, on half-time props or in the stadium seating areas.
- 7. PRESS BOX: entry is at the Home side stairs or elevator. Opponent Coach and Scouts must be on the entry list, please contact TODD MOEBES, Athletic director, at wmoebes@huntsville-isd.org or Lisa Blackburn at lblackburn@huntsville-isd.org
  - a. Scout info: Limited to 2-4 scouts in the designated area in the press box
    - You must register with the Athletic Department. A press box pass will be issued, and you can pick up at the WILL CALL / ticket booth.
    - You must be on the entry list.
    - Complimentary meal/snacks for scout members
  - b. The elevator will be locked 2 minutes prior to the 4th Qtr..

### 8. PARKING -

- a. Visiting football, band, cheer, choir and dance team buses will be parked in the designated areas along Hornet Way. **See attached map.**
- b. Visiting Fans will park in Lot C and Lot D and High School overflow parking
- c. Officials will park in Lot B
- d. Home team will park in Lot A and Overflow lots at HHS.
- 9. **PHOTOGRAPHERS** Videotaping/filming by individuals must have permission from school involved in the contest and may not obstruct the view of other spectators of the contests.

- a. All photographers must be approved by the coach or principal of his or her school or have some kind of identification in order to be on the sideline. It is preferred that the visiting non HISD team photographers contact Lisa Blackburn at <a href="mailto:lblackburn@huntsville-isd.org">lblackburn@huntsville-isd.org</a> 936.435.6136 prior to the game to expedite admittance.
- b. All video personnel should enter the stadium with the team. In the case of inclement weather please see the Stadium Director for further instructions.
- c. Photographers and news outlet personnel are restricted from entering to the coach's box (25 yard line to 25 yard line).
- d. Section 1208 of the University Interscholastic League Constitution and Contest Rules the following is stated:
  - 1. **Videotaping/Filming by Individuals**. Any individual taping or filming must have permission from the schools involved in the contest and may not obstruct the view of other spectators of the contest.
  - 2. **Commercial Uses.** Use of films or tapes for commercial purposes must be approved by all schools involved in the contest.
- 10. **TICKET GATE**: Ticket gates will open 6:00 pm for a 7:00 Kickoff for Varsity Football and/or 1 hour prior to other events.
- 11. **PASS GATE**: Patrons entering Huntsville ISD Stadiums with passes must enter through the Pass Gates only. HISD employees will be admitted by his/her faculty/employee picture badge only at the home gate. Passes accepted: THSCA, TGCA, District UIL (corresponds with HISD District) Senior Citizen Pass (issued from Athletic Office), Minister Pass
