Round Up of Last Week's Games

The Lady Panthers had two away games last week.

On Monday, the Panthers were at Middleburg High School. The junior varsity game was a hard-fought scrappy affair. The Panthers had the majority of the possession but struggled to find the net. The first half ended a goalless tie. The Panthers back line, Juni Weibelt, Peaceful Price, Zaria Jamison and Graci Weibelt, with Naviah Mincy in front and Brook Propes in goal, continued to shut out the Broncos in the second half. The Panthers were finally rewarded twenty-three minutes into the half when Amelia Parmelee sent the ball to Kera Williams who ran into the box to slot the ball past the keeper. The game ended 1 - 0.

The varsity teams then took to the field. The Panthers quickly took control of the game. They moved the ball around the field well and had the majority of

the possession. The Panthers created several goal-scoring opportunities in the first quarter but were unable to find the net. Rikki scored with a lobbed ball that sailed over the keeper and dipped into the net. The first half ended tied at 1 - 1. The second half was a more even affair with both sides pressuring the opposition goal. There were no more goals and the game remained a 1 - 1 tie.

On Thursday, the Panthers were at Clay High School in cold, rainy, miserable conditions. The junior varsity squad worked hard and were able to put pressure on the opposition goal. However, it was the Blue Devils who were first to get on the scoreboard when a forward broke through the defense at the half way line and ran on goal to score in a one-on-one against


