For this reason, we want to lay out our expectations and rules for players and families to follow while being part of the Black Knights football family.

By signing below, players & their families agree to the following expectations, rules, and terms:

Expectations & Rules:

- Be on time: all players are expected to be on time to all team activities that include but are not limited to: weight training, film sessions, community events, fundraising opportunities, practice. Remember our motto: "Early is on time, on time means you're late!"
- Players will show respect when speaking and interacting with any individuals, especially young ladies
- Players are to follow our dress code while at school and all team functions: The dress code is as follows:
 - No crocs, slides, earrings, headwear, baggy pants
 - Must wear a belt
 - On gameday: team polos must be tucked in, must wear khakis
- Players must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA
- Players will speak without utilizing profanity
- No fighting will be tolerated
- Players are expected to be present 100% of the time. Parents must provide exceptional reasoning and documentation when players are absent from school or team activities. We cannot improve if you are not here, and your team relies on your presence
- All team equipment assigned for games and practice must be returned intact and on time
- Players will follow all directions from coaches, teachers, and adults

Terms:

- If players are found to be in breach of our expectations and rules, Coach Harold reserves the right to assign demerits as he sees fit, including but not limited to:
 - After school/practice conditioning
 - Game suspensions
 - Counseling
 - Parent/Player Conference
 - Dismissal from the team
- Player dues are non-refundable, regardless of a player's standing or playing time
