



PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **Attendance** – You are responsible for attending all practices, Games, Bus Departures, and meetings on time. You must notify the coaches in person or via Email, text, or Phone call a minimum of 24hrs ahead of time if unable to attend or if attending late. Failure to do so can result in suspension or dismissal from team. Being late to class or skipping class can result in suspension or dismissal from team. You are expected to be dressed, stretched, taped and ready for practice 10 minutes before the start of practice. Holiday practice for JV and 9th Grade are optional. Varsity players are expected to attend all practices and games over Holiday breaks.
2. **Social Media/ Behavior** - If a player possessing (including videos/pictures on social media) alcohol and or drugs they can be suspended or removed from the team. Theft of any-kind can result in dismissal from team
3. **Academics** - Work hard in all aspects of being an exemplary student athlete. All players must maintain Good academic standing. Players can be dismissed or suspended from team for poor academic performance. any player failing 2 or more classes will be suspended from all basketball related activities.
4. **Dress Code**- No player will wear any athletic gear during games/ practices that are not authorized by coaching staff. Players who don't comply with the dress code can be suspended. Game day attire will be designated by Coach.
5. **Medical Issues**- Any players who need to take any medication i.e. Asthma pumps need to inform coaching and Medical staff about any medications taken. Players who have asthma will not be allowed to participate in any physical activity without having their asthma inhaler on site. All injuries need to be reported to coaching and medical staff immediately.
6. **Transportation** – Players must ride the team bus to all away games when provided. If you choose not to ride the bus back, you can only leave with a parent/guardian and parents must inform coaches via email or signature that you are not riding bus back.. Players must be picked up promptly after all practices and Games. Players who have multiple late pick-ups can be suspended or dismissed from the team.
7. **Technical Fouls**- 1st Infraction can result in suspension- any additional infraction can result in dismissal from team.
8. **Disrespectful Behavior**- Any player that engages in disrespectful behavior to Fans, Coaches, Spectators, Teammates or other parties can be suspended or dismissed from team.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **Practice/ Games** – Parents will make sure that their son attends all practices. All practices are closed to public. No parents or spectators will be allowed in gym during practice. All players must be picked up outside of the gym.. Players must be picked up no later 15 minutes after the end of a practice and Games. Players who are not picked up promptly after practice/ and Games can be dismissed from team. If a player is not riding the bus home after a game, the head coach needs to be notified 24 hrs prior to game by email. players can only ride home with parents or guardians. There will be a sign out sheet for all players not riding the bus home after games.
2. **Behavior** - Parents will treat players, coaches, opponents, and officials with respect and dignity. All comments by parents and their guests from the sidelines will be encouraging and/or complementary. Parents and guests will refrain from making comments about players' mistakes or errors. Parents will refrain from making derogatory comments to referees at any time. Coaching basketball is to be done only by coaches on staff. Parents agree to refrain from coaching or directing their child or other players during all games and practices.
3. **24 Hour Rule** - Parents will discuss player and/or team concerns and problems directly with the head coach. These discussions will not take place right before or after a game. A meeting will not be scheduled within 24 hours before or after a game. During the meeting, playing time and comparisons to other players will not be discussed.
4. **Dues/Fundraising/Lettering** - Parents will support players and program by paying all dues in full and participating an all team fundraising efforts. Players must participate in over %70 of the varsity season in to letter.
