#### 2. Tryout/Practice Forms:

The following forms need to be completed, submitted to the **Athletic Office by July 20**, and cleared by the athletic training staff before any prospective player can attend the July open Courts and Tryouts. To ensure enough time for the process, please have all forms submitted **ASAP** to the Athletic Office.

### There is a new system in place this year:

Parents are encouraged to turn in their paperwork <u>NOW</u> for the 2024/2025 school year to stay ahead of the game. The only paperwork we still accept in the athletic office is the physical form.

If any student athlete is homeschooled, or attends a private school, they <u>CANNOT</u> submit via the new way, and we do have printed copies for them to complete and turn in.

We are in the office all summer long and our hours are 7:30 AM until 4:00 PM (Closed June 19th, July 4th).

Instructions on how to file athletic paperwork...

1) The Physical Form <u>will remain in paper form</u> only. The physician/medical personnel <u>must</u> sign and fill out this form so there is no change with the physical. You can download a copy of the physical from the athletic website or pick one up from the athletic office.

All physicals must be turned into the Athletic Office

2) The Concussion Form, Sudden Cardiac (Lindsey Law) Form and the Athletic Code of conduct are all done through ParentSquare. This link will take you there: <u>www.parentsquare.com/feeds/32282762</u> This link is also on the Athletic Website under Athletic Forms, it is the first link listed. Go to ParentSquare and complete these 3 forms. You will be able to choose all the sports that your child is planning to be a part of.

3) The Emergency Medical Authorization Form is a little different. EMA will be used by Athletics, Clubs, Field Trips, etc...so it will only need to be done once per school year as a part of the Student Registration Packet and you are done! Here is how you will fill out the EMA.

The EMA must be completed every year as part of your Student Registration Forms. Follow these instructions to make sure you've completed the EMA for 2024-25 School Year:

I. Log into the <u>Home Access Center</u>. You must login using the parent/guardian's account (not the student's account).

- II. Click on the Registration icon at the top of the page.
- III. Click on the Update Enrollment tab.

IV. Look for the 2024-2025 Returning Student Data Update. If there is a link to Edit, we still need your child's information for the upcoming school year. If the link says View, you have already submitted the information for the 2024-25 school year.

V. If your child is a new student to Centerville City Schools, your family completed these forms during the enrollment process and will not have to complete them again until next year when you will have a returning student.
