Centerville moves to 3-0 in GWOC play as Ryan continues massive start.

Forget the overall record for a moment. Inside the GWOC, the Elks haven't lost. Centerville improved to 3-0 in conference play Tuesday with a commanding sweep of Miamisburg, 25-12, 25-15, 25-12 — following another straight-set conference win over Springfield.

#1 GWOC · KILLS

Sophomore Tanley Ryan isn't simply leading the GWOC in kills — she's running away with it. Ryan has **97 kills**, while the next closest conference player has 56. That's a 41-kill advantage. Ryan also ranks No. 2 in the GWOC with 65 digs.

Setting the standard: Centerville owns the top two spots in assists — Reagan Conner (124) and Elaina Greenfield (103). Conner also leads the entire conference with 22 aces (No. 1 GWOC).

After battling perennial Cincinnati power Moeller to a 0-0 draw, Centerville's offense broke through in a major way Tuesday: **Centerville 6, Springfield 1**. The victory moved the Elks to 3-1-3 overall and 2-0 GWOC. Centerville has lost only once in seven matches, played Moeller scoreless, and has opened conference play perfectly.

Centerville is one of only three GWOC boys soccer programs still perfect in league play, joining Fairmont and Beavercreek at 2-0.

Nonconference schedule gives way to GWOC play Friday.

The legitimate story is that an extremely challenging nonconference portion of the schedule is over, and conference play starts now. Centerville travels to Fairmont Friday night for its GWOC opener at 7:00 PM at Roush Stadium.

And despite the early team results, several Elks are sitting at or near the very top of the conference statistically. **A.J. Taylor leads the entire GWOC in tackles with 39** — not just Centerville's leader, the conference leader. Right behind him, **Soren Vitas sits at No. 2 with 28 tackles**, giving Centerville the top two spots in the entire conference. Vitas also has 2 sacks, T-No. 1 GWOC.
