

Chagrin Falls Booster Club Athlete Assistance Fund:

It is the belief of the Chagrin Falls Booster Club that all CFEVS students should have the opportunity to participate in a sport, no matter their family financial situation. The Booster Board has designated a portion of the budget to be used as a hardship fund for student athletes who are facing financial difficulty in paying their required Pay to Play fee collected by the CFEVS district. Students/Families will notify the Athletic Director that they are in need of help with this fee. The Athletic Director will then approach the Booster Board indicating the number of students in need of financial assistance. This will allow the student/family to remain anonymous to the Board. In addition to the funds being available for Pay to Play, the funds can also be used to provide financial assistance for necessary sports equipment/ apparel that a student may not be able to afford and are necessary for participation on a team. The request for assistance can again be communicated to the Athletic Director, who will bring the request to the Booster Board. The Boosters would ask for a receipt or other documentation to be provided to indicate the cost of the equipment or apparel. The Chagrin Falls Booster Club Athlete Assistance Fund is not intended to cover team fees collected by parent led team organizations for the purpose of team gifts, coaches gifts, team dinners, or other miscellaneous expenses. Boosters is focused on the necessary needs of the student athlete for participation in competition.
