FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

The following expectations have been established regarding fan conduct:

- Be a positive role model for those around you.
- Display and encourage good sportsmanship at all times.
- Conduct yourself in a manner that represents your school, conference, and the OHSAA with honor, dignity, and respect.
- Cheer positively for your team. Refrain from taunting, threatening, or making vulgar, abusive, racist, sexist, or demeaning remarks or gestures toward coaches, student-athletes, fans, staff, or game officials.
- Respect all facility rules and regulations.
- Sit only in your ticketed seat and present your ticket when requested. Do not stand on seats, stand in aisles, enter the playing area, or throw any objects onto the playing area.
- Follow all local, state, and federal laws, as well as the instructions of event staff.
- Guests who appear intoxicated, impaired, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs may be denied entry or removed from the event. Any intervention will be handled promptly and safely.
- Wear clothing that does not display obscene or indecent messages.
- Remove or cover any clothing deemed offensive or obscene if requested by event staff.
- Be responsible for your own conduct and the conduct of anyone using your tickets.
- No outside food or drinks allowed in the Stadium.
- Sporting equipment—including footballs, basketballs, beach balls, and frisbees—is prohibited inside the stadium during high school athletic contests.
