

TRAINING RULES-INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS MAD RIVER LOCAL SCHOOLS

General Rules:

- Student/Athletes must be eligible academically on the first day of the season in order to try out or participate in interscholastic athletics for Mad River Local Schools.
- Student/Athletes must be behaviorally in good standing throughout the tryout period (for tryout sports) or pre-season for (no tryout sports) in order to remain eligible for interscholastic athletics for Mad River Local Schools.
- Student/Athletes may become ineligible for participation at any time during the tryouts, regular season, or post season.
- If a student becomes academically or behaviorally ineligible to participate, said student/athlete forfeits all awards, honors, and/or participation in post-season banquets/ceremonies.
- These Training Rules are applicable at all school events, travel to and from games/practices, and all school trips under the supervision of school personnel.

Rules Violations:

1. Any Student/Athlete that violates one or more of the following rules or Student CODE OF CONDUCT may be denied participation or suspended from team activities for a period of time:

- **IN-SCHOOL SUSPENSION** (AIM or otherwise)- ineligible to participate in team activities for the days assigned in school suspension. May not travel with team or participate in team activities. May return to active competition following the conclusion of all In School Suspension days.
- **OUT-OF-SCHOOL SUSPENSION** (1-3 Days) ineligible to participate in team activities for the days assigned out school suspension. May not travel with team or participate in team activities. May return to practices at the conclusion of Out of School Suspension days. May return to active competition at the discretion of the Head Coach following established, written guidelines.
- **Unexcused absence from team activities-** Student/Athletes may be removed from team activities following established, written team guidelines.
- **SMOKING, USE, POSSESSION OF TOBACCO OR NON-TOBACCO MATERIALS including VAPES, VAPE PRODUCTS, E-CIGARETTES.** A student shall not smoke, use or possess tobacco, clove cigarettes or other non-tobacco materials that may be used for smoking

2. Any Student/Athlete that violates one or more of the following rules or Student CODE OF CONDUCT will be denied participation and suspended from team activities for a period of time not to exceed the ending date of that activity:

- **NARCOTICS, MARIJUANA, DRUGS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, MOOD ALTERING SUBSTANCES, AND DRUG PARAPHERNALIA.** A student shall not possess, use, transmit, sell, or conceal narcotics, marijuana, drugs, alcoholic beverage, and/or mood-altering substances of any kind, nor shall a student have the odor of alcohol on or about their person. A student shall not possess, use, transmit, sell, and/or conceal drug paraphernalia.
- **SMOKING, USE, POSSESSION OF TOBACCO OR NON-TOBACCO MATERIALS including VAPES, VAPE PRODUCTS, E-CIGARETTES.** A student shall not smoke, use or possess tobacco, clove cigarettes or other non-tobacco materials that may be used for smoking
- **OUT-OF-SCHOOL SUSPENSION (4 or more days).** A student will be ineligible to participate for the remainder of the season.
- **IN-SCHOOL SUSPENSION-** 2 or more occurrences will result in denial of participation for the remainder of the season.
- Verbal and/or physical abuse to members of the athletic staff or members of the team.
- Theft and/or willful destruction of school or personal property.
- Violation of established and posted curfew.
- Behavior detrimental to the image of interscholastic athletics in the Mad River Local Schools.
- Repeated occurrences or combination of occurrences (2 or more) of **IN-SCHOOL SUSPENSION and/or OUT OF SCHOOL SUSPENSIONS**

The above rules are in effect during the official beginning and ending date of that activity. Denial of participation will be for a period not to exceed the ending date of that activity.

If a student has been removed from two extracurricular activities due to a violation of the CODE OF CONDUCT, the student will be prohibited from participating in extracurricular activities for the remainder of their high school career.
