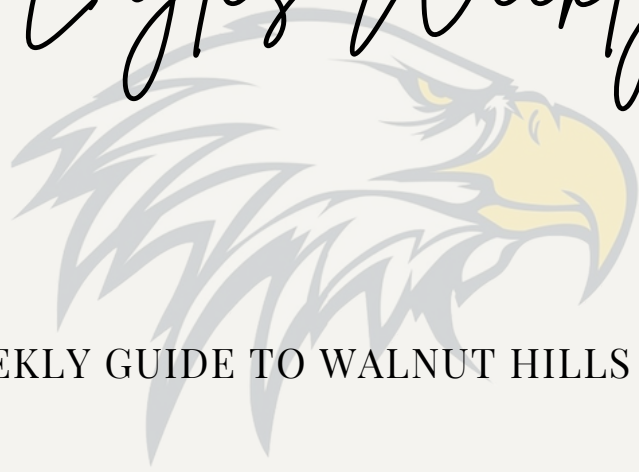

Tony Trabert's story began in the Bond Hill area of Cincinnati, where he attended Walnut Hills High School before becoming one of the greatest athletes in University of Cincinnati history. A standout in both basketball and tennis, Trabert started at point guard for the Bearcats that reached the 1951 National Invitation Tournament, also capturing the 1951 NCAA singles championship, finishing as doubles runner up with partner Bob Norment. His remarkable collegiate accomplishments eventually earned him induction into the University of Cincinnati Athletics Hall of Fame and the prestigious William Howard Taft Medal for his notable achievement. Before embarking on his tennis career, Trabert served two years in the United States Navy aboard the USS Coral Sea during the Korean War.

WHHS All Sports Passes

All Sports Passes MUST be purchased online and are good for use at all WHHS regular season home events (passes are NOT valid for OHSAA post-season events or contests)

Golden Eagle Pass

four adult passes good for ALL regular season games/events, \$500

Eagle Pass

two adult passes good for ALL regular season games/events, \$300

Blue Pass

one adult pass good for ALL regular season games/events, \$150

Nuthouse Pass

one student pass good for ALL regular season games/events, \$85

Eagles Seasonal Pass

one adult pass good for ALL regular season games/events for select season, \$100

Don't want to commit to a pass? No worries! Single tickets are available too. Single game tickets can be purchased online one (1) week prior to the sporting event, or at the gate via cash or card.

Varsity: \$10 adults \$9 students/seniors

JV/F: \$5 adults/students/seniors

JH: \$5 adults \$2 students/senior

All Other Sports:

JV/Varsity: \$8 adults/ \$5 students/seniors

JVB only: \$7 adults \$5 students/seniors

JH: \$5 adults \$2 students/seniors
