(**Revised Plan – 9/23/20**)

Expectations for Spectators and Parents

- 1. Self / Family prescreening for COVID 19
 - a. Any person having any of the following symptoms will refrain from attending games or entering any BISD Facility.
 - i. Temperature of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher;
 - ii. Sore throat;
 - iii. New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline);
 - iv. Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
 - v. New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.
 - b. Or have lab confirmed case of COVID -19
- 2. All non-participants and parents will wear a face covering in accordance to Governors Executive Order GA-29 and practice social distancing when possible.
- 3. All non-participants and spectators will enter through ticket gates located on the Visitor entrance, Moss parking lot or home parking lot only to ensure all regulations are followed and a proper count of tickets sold to stay within the 50% maximum capacity guidelines. Brownsboro ISD will have no in person tickets sold at any gates on Friday night games. Everyone entering the stadium will need to present a valid paper or electronic ticket.
- 4. Once inside the football stadium spectators are asked, not to congregate in isles, walk-ways, entrances, underneath stands, around concession areas or restrooms and to maintain social distancing of 6 ft. when possible. Any person that is purchasing food or drink from the concession stands are asked to wash their hands before and after eating and kindly dispose of their trash to reduce the risk of the spread of COVID 19.
- 5. All non-participants and spectators are not allowed on the field or locker room areas before, during or after any contest and must exit the facility at the completion of the contest using the ticket gates only.
- 6. The bleachers, handrails, restrooms and surface areas will be disinfected in accordance to TEA and UIL guidelines.

Expectations for Teams, Coaches, Trainers, Cheerleaders and Officials

- 1. Self / Family prescreening for COVID 19
 - a. Any person having any of the following symptoms will refrain from attending games or entering any BISD Facility.

- i. Temperature of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher;
- ii. Sore throat;
- iii. New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline);
- iv. Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
- v. New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.
- b. Or have lab confirmed case of COVID -19
- 2. All teams, coaches, trainers, cheerleaders and officials will wear a face covering in accordance to Governors Executive Order GA-29 and practice social distancing when possible.
- 3. Teams, coaches, trainers, cheerleaders and officials will enter and exit through the secured lot behind the drama building located at the south end of the stadium.
- 4. Teams, coaches, trainers, cheerleaders and officials will enter and exit the field using the walkway at the south end of the stadium and through the players gate.
- 5. Teams, coaches, trainers, cheerleaders and officials will use the designated locker room facilities and dressing areas for dressing and restroom purposes.
 - a. Cheerleaders and female team members will use the Drama Building restrooms.
- 6. Coaches/Trainers will ensure that each player / participant have their own individual water source that is not shared with another.
- 7. Coaches, trainers, players, cheerleaders and officials will refrain from direct contact with spectators/parents before, during or after games or contests.
- 8. Once completion of the contest; both teams, trainers, coaches, cheerleaders and officials will exit the stadium through the locker room area only.
- 9. In accordance with UIL guidelines, teams, coaches, trainers, cheerleaders and officials must remain separated from spectators, fans, and other student groups at all times including before, during and after contests or games.

Expectations for Band and Dance Squads

- 1. Self / Family prescreening for COVID 19
 - a. Any person having any of the following symptoms will refrain from attending games or entering any BISD Facility.

- ii. Sore throat;

- iv. Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
- v. New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.
- b. Or have lab confirmed case of COVID -19
- All band, dance members and sponsors will wear a face covering in accordance to Governors Executive Order GA-29 and practice social distancing.
- 3. Home band and dance squads will enter and exit through Bear Drive gate and sit in the bleachers in the south end of the home bleachers and socially distance in accordance to the UIL requirements. Band and Dance squad members will use the Drama Building restrooms.
- 4. Home band and dance squads will enter and exit the field using the stairway at the south end of the field.
- 5. Visiting band and dance squads will park in the visitor's lot directly behind the visitor stands.
- 6. Visiting band and dance squads will enter the band gate located behind the visitor's concession area and sit in the north end of the visitors stand and are required to maintain social distancing in accordance to the UIL guidelines.
- 7. Visiting band and dance squads will enter the field using the walk gate located on the visiting sideline.
- 8. Band and Dance Sponsors will ensure that participants have their own individual water source that is not shared with another.
- 9. Band members, dance squads and sponsors will refrain from direct contact with spectators / parents before, during or after games or contests.
- 10. Once completion of the contest; band and dance squads will exit through the band gate and load buses in the visitor parking lot.
- 11. In accordance with UIL guidelines, band, dance squads and sponsors must remain separated from spectators, fans, and other student groups at all times.


