Cornerstone Scholar Athlete Program
2018 – 2019

The purpose of the Cornerstone Program is to recognize Junior and Senior students currently involved in HPISD-sponsored athletic teams, cheerleading, drill team, or athletic training and HPHS-sponsored Field Hockey, Ice Hockey, Lacrosse, and Crew athletic teams who exhibit excellent performance in all that they do. All students involved in eligible activities can receive this honor as juniors, seniors, or in both years, if they apply and meet the criteria.

Applications will be evaluated and points awarded in the following areas:

1. **Cumulative grade point average** through the 1st semester of the current school year. Minimum GPA is 2.5. **Counselor's verification/signature is required.**
2. **Signature of coach of eligible athletic activity is required.**
3. **Total number of high school PreAP, AP, and TAG classes** taken during high school career through the first semester of the current school year. **Counselor's verification/signature- is required.**
4. **Total number of extra-curricular HPHS sponsored activities** participated in during the high school career, through the current school year. (i.e. athletics, student council, drill team, cheerleading, service club officer, band, orchestra, academic decathlon, etc.) The student must be in good standing with the organization and have been a member for at least one full semester. **ALL sponsors' signatures are required.**

To qualify for the award, students must score 16 of 21 possible points (75%).

It is the desire of the Athletic Department and HPISD to give every Junior and Senior involved in HPISD-sponsored athletic activities and HPHS-sponsored Field Hockey, Ice Hockey, Lacrosse, and Crew teams the opportunity to apply for this award if they so desire. Please complete the attached application and **return it to the main Athletic Office,** located in Highlander Stadium, no later than **4:00 PM, Friday, February 15, 2018.** **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
