

## Kleb Intermediate Athletic Department Policies & Guidelines

As a student-athlete, at Kleb Intermediate, below are the policies & guidelines that are expected of all participants. Failure to adhere to these may result in disciplinary action. Repeated failure to comply may result in the removal of a student-athlete from Kleb Intermediate athletics.

1) Student-athletes are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner, at all times, in the school building, practice setting, and all competitions.

2) Student-athletes are required to have the appropriate uniforms, and equipment, for all practices and competitions.

3) Student-athletes are required to attend all practices, to prepare for upcoming competitions, review prior performance, and practice skills/drills/techniques.

\*\*It is the responsibility of the student-athlete to notify their coach should they be absent from practice or competitions. Repeated absences will result in reduced playing time. Should repeated absences occur, the student-athlete may be removed from the Kleb Intermediate sports program.

4) Student-athletes will adhere to appropriate locker room conduct, such as keeping area clean, maintaining a secured locker with the Kleb issued lock, and no horseplay.

5) Student-athletes will adhere to Klein ISD's student code of conduct policies. Should an athlete not comply with the C.O.C., reduced practice or playing time may occur. Depending on the severity of the infraction, student-athlete may be removed from the Kleb Intermediate Athletic program.

6) Student-athletes that quit a school sport, during the season, will be removed from the Kleb Athletic program potentially for the remainder of the current school year. Student-athletes will still have the opportunity to compete in other sports.

\*Please note that other various occurrences of non-compliance/student-code of conduct issues may result in disciplinary action, reduced playing time, or removal from the athletic program. Each individual athlete will be handled on a case by case situation.
