Frequently Asked Questions – PNG Ticket Sales

The following list of questions pertains to the PNG (home side) ticket sales.

Q: When and where is the Mid-County Madness game?

A: PNG vs. Nederland is Friday, October 25 at 7:00pm at Indian Stadium.

Q: When and where can I purchase a general admission (adult) ticket? How much are they?

A: General admission tickets are sold online for \$7.00 each. Tickets go on sale online Monday, October 21 at 9:00am. You can click on either of the links below to purchase tickets, or download the HomeTown fan app.

- **HomeTown Fan App:** If you have the HomeTown Fan app on your phone, search for “PNG High School” in the explore tab and purchase tickets within the app.

Q: Are there any rules or restrictions on general admission tickets? Do I have to be a PNGISD resident?

A: There is a 6-ticket max limit per person. No, you do not have to be a PNGISD resident to purchase.

Q: Where is the General Admission section?

A: The general admission section is Section G, and it's the section nearest to the scoreboard.

Q: When and where can I purchase a student ticket?

A: Student tickets are not sold online. Student tickets are sold at PNG High School, Port Neches Middle School, and Groves Middle School only. Student tickets go on sale Monday, October 21. Students are limited to 1 ticket and the cost is \$5.00 (cash only).

Q: How do I purchase a handicapped ticket?

A: Please call the athletic office at 409.729.7644 to purchase handicapped tickets.

Q: Can I purchase a general admission ticket for my student?

A: Yes, general admission tickets can be purchased for anyone of any age.

Q: At what age does a child need a ticket?

A: Children 4 and under do not need a ticket. However, your child must sit in your lap unless you purchase them a ticket.

Q: I purchased general admission tickets online. How do I get them?

A: Your receipt and tickets will be emailed to you. Click or tap on the View Tickets button or open the attachment with your tickets. You can print paper tickets or download and save your tickets digitally.

Q: Can I purchase tickets at the ticket booth or at the gate?

A: No, tickets are not sold in person at the ticket booth or at the gate.

Q: Are Purple Cards accepted?

A: No, Purple Cards are not accepted. Everyone must have a ticket.

Q: Are PNGISD Employee badges accepted?

A: No, PNGISD employee badges are not accepted. Everyone must have a ticket.

Q: My child is in athletics. Will he/she be able to use his/her athletic pass?

A: No, athlete passes for high school and middle school athletes are not accepted at this game. They will need a ticket.

Q: Are UIL Passes accepted?

A: No, UIL passes are not accepted at this game. Everyone must have a ticket.

Q: What time will the gate open?

A: The gates open at 5:30pm.

Q: What are the stadium policies?

A: All bags brought in must be clear. Outside food, drinks, and food/drink containers (i.e. Yeti cups, Stanley cups, fast food drinks, etc.) are not allowed. Stadium seats cannot exceed 18" in width. To view the full stadium rules, click the link below.

Q: Can I get in free after halftime or during the 4th quarter?

A: No. There is no free admittance at any time. All spectators must have a ticket.

Q: Can I leave the stadium during the game and return?

A: No, there is no re-entry. Please see a gate usher if you have an emergency.
