High School football starts on August 4th for our 9th-12th graders, and we wanted to touch base with all of you today regarding a few things to start the year.

SportsYou: SportsYou is our primary communication source. You will receive weekly schedules, itineraries, and up to date information through SportsYou. Players, Parents, and Supporters can join our SportsYou. Download the SportsYou app, and use this code *SV6L9Q85*

<u>7th/8th/9th Grade Football Camp</u>: All 7th-9th grade football players are highly encouraged to attend our Sabine Cardinal Football Camp. The cost of the camp is \$45, and it will run from 8:00 Am-10:00 Am on July 28, 29, 30 in the stadium. If payment is an issue, please speak with me. Equipment Pick Up: HS players can pick up their equipment, and organize their fieldhouse locker on the following dates at 4 PM: Seniors/Juniors- July 28, Sophomores- July 29, Freshman- July 30 after morning camp, or at 4 PM. MS players will get their equipment on their first day of practice. High school players who do not get equipment early will want to arrive one hour early on their first day of practice.

HS Practice Times Week 1:

9th Grade Only: August 4th-7th- 6:45 AM-9 AM

10th-12th Grade Only: August 4th-7th- 3:30 PM-7 PM

<u>August 8th</u>- All Players: 6:45 AM-9:30 AM, After practice, all players will be taken by a bus to the Kilgore City pool from 10:30 AM-12:30 PM for team building/swimming. Players will need to bring their swim trunks and a towel on August 8th. We will return to the school around 1 PM for lunch, and the players will be released around 2:00 PM.

August 9th- All players will practice from 7 AM-8 AM before pictures and media day.

Media Day: Media/Picture day will be in the stadium on Saturday August 9th starting at 8:30 AM after Saturday morning practice. We will do pictures for our sports program. We invite parents and families to join us for practice on the 9th, and for pictures afterwards.

**We will do life touch photos later on in the football season for High School and Middle School football. These photos will be during their athletic period on October 28th. I will share a Life touch code with you as we get closer.

MS Practice Times: The 8th grade will practice at 7:15 AM on Monday and Wednesday, and they will practice at 7:30 AM on Tuesday/Thursday. The 7th grade will practice at 3:50 PM after school Monday-Wednesday. Middle school practice times will always be reflected on the weekly schedule on SportsYou.

Parent Meeting: We will have a parent meeting for 7th-12th grade parents/guardians on August 5th at 6:00 PM in the HS auditorium. The booster club will be offering 2025 Memberships and new merchandise will be for sale. The parent meeting should wrap up in 30 minutes or less.

<u>Cleats/Accessories</u>: We do not provide cleats for the HS or the MS. All cleats and accessories (gloves, wrist bands, etc.) need to be purchased in a white, red, black, grey, or royal blue color.

<u>Sept 1 & Oct 20:</u> These are days we do not have school. We will have Varsity, JV Red, and JV Blue practice at 7:00 AM on these days. This is required for our players to attend. There will be no middle school practice on these days.

<u>Tickets:</u> We have five home games this season. Season ticket renewal emails will go out on Monday 7/28. This will have renewal instructions, and allow you to purchase starting that day. On August 11th, any season tickets not renewed will go active for the public to purchase.
