



Whitehouse Independent School District Visitor Screener for COVID-19

Whitehouse ISD is required to screen all visitors to determine if they have COVID-19 symptoms, are lab-confirmed with COVID-19, or have had close contact with an individual who is lab-confirmed with COVID-19. Screening questions may be supplemented with temperature check of adults.

Have you recently begun experiencing **any** of the following in a way that is not normal for you?

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Significant muscle pain or aches
- Headache
- Loss or taste of smell
- Sore throat
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

In the past 14 days, have you had close contact with an individual who is lab-confirmed with COVID-19?

Are you lab-confirmed with COVID-19?

If you answered **yes** to **any** of the above:

- You must remain off campus until cleared to return
- Contact the campus nurse for more information

Reminders to follow when you are cleared to return:

- Wear a mask or face covering
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer regularly
- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet
