Remember that for the first six months after the issuance of the intermediate driver's license or until the holder reaches eighteen years of age, which occurs first, the holder of the license may not operate a vehicle that is carrying any passengers under the age of twenty who are not members of the holder's immediate family. For the remaining period of the intermediate license, the holder may not operate a vehicle that is carrying more than three passengers who are under the age of twenty who are not members of the holder's immediate family.
