STUDENT ELIGIBILITY FOR JUNIOR HIGH ATHLETICS 2019-2020

Section 1400: JUNIOR HIGH (7TH & 8TH GRADE)

- (a) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR 7TH AND 8TH GRADE PARTICIPANTS.
- (1) Student's Eligibility. An individual may participate in League competition or contest as a representative of the participant school he/she attends if that student has been in attendance and has passed the number of courses required by state law and by rules of the State Board of Education, and is passing the number of courses required by state law and by rules of the State Board of Education.
- (2) The Constitution and Contest Rules does not prohibit junior high students from competing at a grade level higher than the one in which they are enrolled. Refer to Subchapter M for high school eligibility standards.
- (3) To participate in athletic competition, a student who initially entered the 7th or 8th grade during the current school year and has a special needs condition which delayed his or her education by at least one year, and students who are overage due to limited English proficiency, and who have substantiation from a language proficiency assessment committee, may petition the UIL to participate at grade level. The following must be submitted to the UIL for eligibility determination (not required for non-athletic competition.)
- (A) A special education student must provide documentation of a special education status and documentation that a disability delayed his or her education by at least one year.
- (B) A student with a history of a disability must provide documentation from a 504 committee or an ARD committee proving the existence and length of time of the disability that caused the delay of at least one year in his or her education.
- (C) A student with limited English proficiency must provide documentation of their recommendation of the LPAC.
- (D) Students must provide documentation of date of birth and a copy of a current physical, including height and weight.
- (E) The district executive committee may appeal the decision of the UIL to the State Executive Committee.

Section 1478: SEVENTH AND EIGHTH GRADE ATHLETIC PLAN

(B) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SEVENTH AND EIGHTH GRADE PARTICIPANTS. An individual may participate in League athletic competition or contest as a representative of a participant school if he/she: (1) Has met the requirements of Section 1400 (a) regarding general eligibility: (2) For seventh grade athletic competition, has not reached his/her 14th birthday on or before September 1, and has not enrolled in the ninth grade. (3) For eighth grade athletic competition, has not reached his/her 15th birthday on or before September 1ST and has not enrolled in the ninth grade.

DISTRICT 31-5A U.I.L. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Penalty for Student Disciplinary Ejections During U.I.L. Sport Events

Effective October 2010

The purpose of ensuring student safety and sportsmanship during all U.I.L. sporting events, the District 31-5A U.I.L executive Committee hereby imposes the following disciplinary penalty to any student ejected from a game for fighting or engaging in unnecessary physical activity.

This Committee hereby moves that all Middle and Junior High School students in District 31-5A who are ejected from an athletic event by an official for fighting or engaging in serious unnecessary physical contact, which includes hitting, slapping, punching, biting, spitting, scratching, or kicking, and as determined excessive by the presiding official, shall be suspended from U.I.L. play and practices for the following game or sporting event in which they are involved in.

Students who are ejected from an athletic event for a second fight in a year shall be suspended from play for the remainder of the season or 30 days, whichever is longer. This suspension may carry over to another sport should the suspension window go beyond the athletic event in which the expulsion occurred. In addition, this committee further asserts that all ejection decisions rendered by an official shall stand as called on the field or court, and shall not be appealable to the U.I.L. Executive Committee for reconsideration or reversal.

Lastly, the Committee determines that the host school of any student who is ejected from a game shall notify the Executive committee Chairperson through the "Ineligible Notice for Ejected Players" form within 48 hours of the incident.

 Students who fight during a game and are not ejected by the officials will only be subject to home school disciplinary consequences as determined by the school administrator.

I. District Competition

- 1. District competition consists of 7 district schools
- 2. Extra Point: Kick = 2pts, Runner or Pass = 1pt

II. Game Days and Sites

- 1. 8thgrade "A" will play on Tuesday night "B" team will play opposite site.
- 2. 7th grade "A" will play on Monday night "B" team will play opposite site.
- 3. Games begins at 5:30 pm
- 4. 15 minute warm up time for the "A" teams will be given even upon late arrival
- 5. 8thgrade teams 8 minute quarters
- 6. 7thgrade teams 8 minute quarters
- 7. Coaches may mutually agree to modify these times

III. Game Uniforms and Equipment

1. Each school will provide their own footballs

Optional use of:

- -7th- Youth size 8/Wilson Football or equal. NO COMPOSITES must be Leather
- -8th regular Leather Footballs, NO COMPOSITES
- 2. Home team will wear dark jerseys
- 3. Visiting team will wear light jerseys

IV. Officials

- 1. It is recommended that the home school will provide 3 officials if possible but not less than 2.
- 2. Each school must provide a chain gang ready to go at game time.
- 3. Every effort should be made to ensure that the games will be played even if a coach has to officiate the games. This should be mutually agreed upon by both coaches and administrators.
- 4. Referees must refer/adhere to District Plan.
- 5. Officials cannot decide to run the clock. Only the coaches if both agree, will decide to run the clock.

V. **OFFICIAL GAMES**

- 1. Games will be counted towards district record if 2 quarters have been completed. After half time, a game will be considered a game, if the game has to end early.
- 2. The team with the most points will win the game. (UIL Executive Board minutes 10-26-06)
- 3. Each team will play at least until half time to call it a game. If not, the game does not count towards the standing. (UIL Executive Board minutes 10-26-06)

VI. 2nd Half Rule: 30 points

1. Coaches have the right to approach opposing coach at any point in the second half of the game and request the coach to run the clock as to not run up the score. The Officials do not decide.

VII. Home Team Responsibilities

- 1. Must provide access to sideline benches.
- 2. Ambulance/ Medical service on site.
- 3. Campus Administrator on site.
- 4. Each team must provide own water and cups.
- 5. Adult scorekeeper / clock operator

VIII. Fees

- 1. \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students. Any child under the age of 4 will go in free
- *****Weather may not cause a game to be forfeited if this occurs; the game needs to be rescheduled within the week or sometime before the season ends.
- *** Schools must provide workers who have prior knowledge in the event they are working on. If a problem occurs, the school coach must provide a football coach to continue with the event in question.

I. Scoring and New Rule

- 1. Scoring will include 2 out of 3 games; rally score to 25 with a two (2) point advantage. Cap at 30
- 2. Third game to 25 points cap at 30
- 3. Net serve is allowed
- 4. Libero rule will be in effect (must be in different uniform)
- 5. Added rule: Libero will be allowed to serve in one rotational position in the course of the game.
- 6. No excessive celebration after game. (Example banging on gym floor)

II. Pre-Game Warm-Up Time

- 1. 10 minutes to be put on the game clock before game time
- 2. 4 minutes on the court visiting team
- 3. 4 minutes on the court home team
- 4. 2 minutes shared serving
- 5. Pre-game music must have principal approval

III. Match Limitations

- 1. No team or player may participate in more than twelve matches plus two individual tournaments in a season. This shall be inclusive of both district and non-district games.
- 2. All junior high teams are allowed one contest per week.
- 3. "B" teams will be required to play a mandatory third game even if the winner has been determined in the first two games. Any student who has not played in the first two games must be allowed to participate in the entire 3rd game. The scoring of this game will be Cap at 25. No courtesy game in tournament play and 3rd game will be cap at 15.

IV. Official SHALL BE members of TASO

- 1. Official Fees: (UIL) TWO OFFICIALS (CHAPTER MEMBERS)SHALL BE ASSIGNED
- 2. An adult must run the book, and the Clock for District game/1 adult for book tournament
- 3. Home team shall provide 6-8 volleyballs and a cart or rack for the visiting team only during district games and tournaments.
- 4. One linesman shall be provided by each team and that linesman may be a manager or a player in games and tournaments.
- 5. District Ball MUST BE AN APPROVED UIL CONTEST BALL
- 6. Net Height 7'4 1/4
- 7. If officials leave during courtesy game, the coaches **MUST** officiate the game
- 8. If only one association official is present, a coach will then have to officiate the game.
- 9. Officials must refer/adhere to District Plan

V. Scheduling

- 1. 7th and 8th grade games will be played on Monday nights. 8TH teams will follow the schedule. 7TH team will play at opposite site. The "B" team will play at 5:30 pm and the "A" team will play at 6:30 pm
- 2. Communicate prior to game to confirm times
- 3. If team is going to be late, game will still be played; late team will be allowed 10-minute warm-up prior to starting the game.
- 4. All necessary efforts must be made to play game.

VI. Home Team Must Provide

- 1. Administrator on site
- 2. Water and Cups/Squirt Bottles
- 3. Dressing Rooms
- 4. 6-8 practice balls
- 5. First Aid equipment including ice
- 6. Adult scorekeeper / clock operator

- 6. Athletic Directors or Coordinators will have one vote per school on an appeal of a ruling made by the meet referee.
- 7. Rubber bands are allowed, but objects such as beads will not be allowed during competition.
- 8. caps, or bandanas will not be allowed during competition.
- 9. Give athletes ample time to rest between events when participating in field events and running events.
- 10. Shot / Discus will be weighed and marked prior to competition (Girls shot 6 pounds and Boys 4 kilo, Girls Discus 1K and Boys 1K).
- 11.3200 meter run will be run separately.
- 12. Hurdle Heights:
 - i. 100 meter girls 30"
 - ii. 110 meter boys 36"
 - iii. 300 meter girls30"
 - iv. 300 meter boys 30"

13. Two Day Track Meet

- i. Monday Field events starting at 5:00 pm, 3200 meter run included that night at 5:00pm.
- ii. Wednesday Running events starting at 5:00pm.
- 14. Pole Vault athlete must use weight appropriate pole, pole must show weight and athlete must be weighed in at the District Meet. Athlete's weight must be equivalent to the pole's indicated weight limit or under.
- 15. Each school will be responsible to feed their adult workers.
- *** Schools must provide workers who have prior knowledge in the event they are working on. If a problem occurs, the school coach must provide a track coach to continue with the event in question.

- 2. There will be 4 divisions:

- 3. The course will be 3200 meters long.
- 4. The games committee will be called upon for assistance if there is a concern that arises during the meet. The games committee will consist of head coaches of teams that are not involved in the concern.
- 5. A licensed athletic trainer will be provided for emergency purposes.
- 6. Uniform regulations will be enforced. Coaches please adhere to the uniform regulations cited in the NHFS & UIL track and field manual.
- 7. National High School Federation rules and UIL rules will be followed.
- 8. Schools must provide 2 workers if needed who are knowledgeable in the area they are going to work.
- 9. Time of the meet will be determined by the head coaches of each participating school.
- 10. District meet will start at 8:00 am with the order listed above.
- 11. At the district meet, runners will be removed from the course after 20 minutes.

*** Schools must provide workers who have prior knowledge in the event they are working on. If a problem occurs, the school coach must provide a track coach to continue with the event in question.

BOYS AND GIRLS GOLF PLAN 2019-2020

I. Fees:

1. A \$15.00 maximum per day entry fee (including range fee for each invitational tournament held at Municipal golf course. A \$5.00maximum per student (including range fee) for each invitational tournament held on Private or Country Club golf courses

II. REGULAR TOURNAMENTS:

- 1. Prior to the first tournament of the season, coaches will meet to set up tournament dates and to determine who will be hosting tournaments.
- 2. All Tournaments will be 7 holes for the girls, 7 holes for the boys. Holes will be predetermined by coaches at the coach's meeting. District 9 holes will be played.
- 3. Players will be required to pick up once 3 over par have been attained.
- 4. Balls hit into water hazards may be dropped on the opposite side in a marked drop zone with a penalty stroke. Drop zones will be predetermined by coaches prior to the first tournament of the season.
- 5. Play-offs between individuals as well as teams will be score card based
- 6. For individual ties, tie-breakers will be based on handicap
- 7. Tie-breaker between teams will be based on who has the lowest individual score on the team. If still tied, we will go to the next lowest score on the team.
- 8. Seventh and eighth graders will be on mixed teams.
- 9. Schools will be limited to ten girls and ten boys from each district for tournament play.
- 10. Parents may rent a cart at the regular club rate if they wish to observe players during tournaments.
- 11. Parents must stay on the cart path only and may not coach or advise the players in any capacity during tournament play.
- 12. Only coaches may determine rulings in questionable situations during tournament.
- 13. Players will exchange scorecards during tournament.
- 14. Every stroke will be counted, including whiffs occurring on the tee box, in the fairway, or in hazards.
- 15. Golfers may use pull carts
- 16. There will be a minimum of five tournaments per season.
- 17. Each district school will be responsible for providing their own administrative support when HOSTING tournaments.
- 18. For district tournament-schools must provide 4 WORKERS FOR FRIDAY.
- 19. Tournament of Friday must begin after the end of the school day for all schools

III. DISTRICT TOURNAMENT

- 1. Each coach will provide a list of the top ten players on or before the Friday prior to the district tournament for the purpose of seeding.
- 2. There will be no more than six players per group during tournament play.
- 3. A list of monitors will be provided by each coach on or before the Friday prior to the district tournament for planning purposes.
- 4. High school golfers or coaches may be used as monitors. Must provide workers that have prior knowledge in golf. If no workers show up then the coach of the school must work the event.
- 5. Parents may not serve as monitors.
- 6. Trophies will be given to the 1st place team winner.
- 7. Trophies will be given to individual players on the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.
- 8. Trophies will also be given to individual winners 1st through 3rd place.
- 9. Hosting school will need to provide five trophies per team place.
- *** Schools must provide workers who have prior knowledge in the event they are working on.

 If a problem occurs, the school coach must provide a golf coach to continue with the event in question.

MEETS

All meets will be scheduled by each team's respective coach excluding the District meet which will be held as agreed upon by the participating schools in accordance with UIL standards.

ASSIGNMENT OF OFFICIALS:

- a. It is recommended that at least four officials shall be hired and paid by the host team for invitational meets. The suggested rate of pay will be \$50.00 for the duration of the meet for the Starter and Referee. Other officials may be paid at a rate of \$30.00 per contest.
- b. It is recommended for dual meets and invitational's that officials be certified by the UIL.
- c. It is recommended that 4 officials be USA certified as well as UIL certified.
- The District meet: The meet time and place will be determined by the host team as per availability of the meet officials and facility. It is suggested that diving warm-up start on Friday at 4:00 pm and the diving meet start before 4:30 pm. It is suggested the swim meet warm-up start at 8:00 am and the meet start at 9:00 am on Saturday.
 - 1. The District Meet will be held at Mission Aquatic Center.
 - 2. Entries will be due Wednesday (April 22th) prior to the District Meet at the host's pool after 6:00pm. Entries must follow UIL rules and regulation. Late entries or changes to entries will be accepted at 7:30 8:00am. Entries must be submitted on Hy-Tek disk with a hard copy which will be the official entry list. It is required that the times listed reflect what the swimmer has done during the current season. Dive sheets for each diver must be completed and printed out from Edive. Signed and turned in with the swimming entries.
 - 3. Medals will be awarded for 1st-3rd place in all events. Ribbons will be provided to 4th-8th places if the district chair approves. Awards will be the responsibility of the District Chair.
 - 4. A maximum of 4 events per swimmer. 2 individual & 2 relay or 1 individual & 3 relays. Each swimmer & diver must represent their school, not the city unless there are not enough swimmers in that school for relays if this occurs, they then may swim as an exhibition relay with another school.
 - 5. 4 swimmers per event & only 1 relay per event. Exhibition swimmers will be allowed.
 - 6. DIVING: 6-dives/ four categories.

SWIMMING Meet

1. RULES:

The National Federation of High School Rules shall govern League Meets. UIL Rules if different from the National Federation Rules will be enforced.

2. **SECURITY:**

The host school will provide security and/or administrator in accordance with the School District's policy.

3. INVITATIONALS:

- a. Each school district that will host a meet will set a time, date, and site for their invitational.
- b. The meet will be run using HY-Tek Meet Manager and Edive software that is able to integrate results with the program run at the Regional Meet and post with TISCA. The meet director will be responsible for and have full authority for the management of the meet.
- c. The original host institution is the meet director, even if there is a change in site.
- d. An athletic trainer needs to be available and provided for by the host team and on deck at all times.
- e. Host facility will provide a minimum of 2 (3 is preferred) lifeguards for the meet.

4. TIME SCHEDULE:

- a. Starting time of dual meets shall be by mutual agreement.
- b. A minimum of 30 minutes warm-up shall be provided prior to the start of the meet.
- c. When possible lane assignments for warm-up will be assigned. All warm-ups need to be controlled for safety, following the UIL guidelines.

5. Filming:

a. Videotaping or filming must follow UIL regulations. Video and photograph is prohibited from being taken behind the starting block area.

6. **COACHES RESPONSIBILITY**:

- a. It is required that the district chairperson or meet host finds a trainer for the district meet.
- b. The coaches are responsible for the behavior of their teams and themselves at all meets.

 An administrator will report undesirable behavior to the DISTRICT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
- c. Fairness and sportsmanship are integral parts of all swimming and diving events; i.e., good sportsmanship is not only expected but it is required of all participants.
- 7. Each school must provide 2 Coaches.

*** Schools must provide workers who have prior knowledge in the event they are working on. If a problem occurs, the school coach must provide a swim coach to continue with the event in question.
