TUITION ASSISTANCE

Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGOs)

As part of the Alabama Accountability Act, students from public and home schools may qualify for an SGO scholarship. These scholarships are provided by external organizations and are renewable annually as long as income eligibility guidelines are met. **SGO scholarships may transfer from middle school to high school.** JPII partners with three SGOs: C2 Opportunity Scholarships, Rocket City SGO, and Scholarships for Kids.

The CHOOSE Act

Signed into law by Governor Kay Ivey on March 7, 2024, the CHOOSE Act makes refundable income tax credits available in an educational savings account (ESA) to pay up to \$7,000 of tuition and other qualifying educational expenses to qualifying students, renewable annually. Students cannot receive ESA funds and also have a scholarship from a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO).

JPII Internal Financial Aid

Offered to families who do not qualify for an external SGO scholarship or the Choose Act. Internal financial aid must be re-applied for annually via FACTS Grant & Aid. Students who receive an SGO scholarship are not eligible for internal financial aid. Internal financial aid does not transfer from middle school to high school.

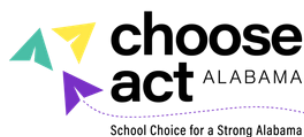
