- 4. I understand that, unless a mileage expense has been previously agreed to by the District, I will be operating my vehicle at my own expense.
- 5a. <u>This statement applies to a volunteer of the District</u>: I have attached a signed Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) printout of my driving record.
- 5b. <u>This statement applies to certificated or classified District employees or a paid walk-on coach</u>: I have completed the DMV Pull Notice Authorization Program form through InformedK12.
- 6. I also understand that Education Code §35330 applies to me when I drive my vehicle on a school field trip. It reads in part "...All persons making the field trip or excursion shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the district or the State of California for injury, accident, illness, or death occurring during or by reason of the field trip or excursion..."

I understand that this means the District is not liable for any accident or injury which I may be involved in or cause, or any damage to my vehicle.
