MISSION

VISION

PHILOSOPHY

IT ALLOWS STUDENTS THE PLATFORM TO WORK WITH OTHERS TO FACE ADVERSITY, PLACE OTHERS BEFORE THEMSELVES, AND BECOME WELL ROUNDED INDIVIDUALS. ATHLETICS IS A MEANS BUT NOT AN END. VICTORY IS JUST ONE ASPECT OF COMPETING AT A HIGH LEVEL BUT OUR PROGRAM DESIRES TO PREPARE STUDENTS TO COMPETE AT A HIGH LEVEL IN LIFE.

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GAMEPLAN

THE METHOD OF WHICH WE CARRY OUT OUR MISSION IN ATHLETICS IS LISTED BELOW

- **DEVELOP** - SKILL AND CHARACTER HAS TO SIMULTANEOUSLY BE DEVELOPED TO IMPACT THE OVERALL STUDENT
- **COMPETE** - IN THE PROCESS OF DEVELOPMENT WE WANT STUDENT TO COMPETE AT A HIGH LEVEL ON THE AREA OF COMPETITION NEVER SACRIFICING CHARACTER. OUR INTENTION IS FOR THIS TO TRANSLATE TO THE CLASSROOM, WORKFORCE, AND ANY OTHER AREA THAT REQUIRES COMPETITIVE PRACTICES

- FIRST AID TREATMENT CERTIFICATION
- CONCUSSION TREATMENT CERTIFICATION
- BACKGROUND CHECK VIA FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE
- COACHING CERTIFICATION OBTAINED BEFORE THE 3RD YEAR OF COACHING FOR INWOOD ACADEMY (3 COURSES)
 - 1) Philosophy, principles, and organization of athletics in education
 - 2) Health sciences applied to coaching
 - 3) Theory and techniques of coaching the sport
- COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO UPHOLD THE STANDARD OF EXCELLENCE AND REPRESENTATION OF INWOOD ACADEMY BY MAINTAINING OUR CORE VALUES IN ALL MOMENTS OF COACHING ASSIGNMENT
- INVITATION OF 3RD PARTY ATTENDEES TO PRACTICE MUST BE APPROVED
 - FRIENDS, STUDENT SIBLINGS, COACHING ASSISTANCE
- COACHES MUST PLAN PRACTICES AHEAD OF TIME WITH ATTENTION TO DETAIL
- COACHES MUST SEEK METHODS TO IMPROVE COACHING KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL, STUDENTS OF THE GAME
- EXPERIENCE IS PREFERRED BUT NOT REQUIRED DEPENDING ON THE LEVEL OF TEAM

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RESPONSIBILITIES

THE FOLLOWING ARE LISTED EXPECTATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH INWOOD ACADEMY COACHING CULTURE. WE ALL BRING DIFFERING EXPERIENCES TO COACHING FROM VARIOUS PARTS OF LIFE HOWEVER, COACHING AT INWOOD HAS ITS UNIQUE SET OF RESPONSIBILITIES ALIGNED WITH OUR CULTURE.

- GOAL SETTING
- ROSTER MANAGEMENT AND STANDARD OF CHARACTER
- ATTENDANCE MUST BE TAKEN TO TRACK PARTICIPATION AND FOR SAFETY ON FINALFORMS
- COACHES MUST FAMILIARIZE THEMSELVES WTH OUR FINALFORMS PLATFORM
- FINALFORMS PROVIDES ACCURATE INFORMATION RELATED TO ATHLETES AND PARENTS/GUARDIANS
 - ELIGIBILITY WITH REQUIRED PAPERWORK
 - ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY
 - INJURY UPDATE
 - ELIGIBILITY REGARDING BEHAVIOR EXPECTATION
- CONTINUED STUDENT OF THE GAME AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT
- CALCULATED AND INTENTIONALLY PLANNED PRACTICES
- MAINTAINING EQUIPMENT
 - UNIFORMS MUST BE RETURNED AFTER EVERY GAME
- UNDERSTANDING OF SCHOOL SPECIFIC ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS
- COMMUNICATION WITH ALL PARTIES VIA SPORTSYOU APP
 - SENDING WEEKLY SCHEDULE OF PRACTICES AND GAMES
 - DEPARTURE TIMES AND RETURN TIMES FOR AWAY GAMES
- PROPER HOME AND AWAY EVENT ATTIRE
- FAMILIARIZATION WITH INWOOD ATHLETICS WEBSITE
 - ENSURE
 - ACCURATE ROSTERS, SCHEDULE, UPCOMING EVENTS ON CALENDAR
 - UTILIZE COACHES CORNER
- COMMUNICATE WITH ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT ON SCHEDULE CHANGES AND APPROVAL FOR CHANGES, ESPECIALLY FOR SITES
- ALL INJURIES MUST BE REPORTED USING INJURY REPORT FORM
- COMPLETE END OF SEASON TASK
- REPORTING ALL SCORES AND PROPER SCORE KEEPING
- ANY REMOVAL OR STUDENT QUITING FROM TEAM MUST BE OFFICIALLY COMMUNICATED WITH PARENTS AND ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT

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RESPONSIBILITIES CONT.D

- COACHES MUST UPHOLD THE STANDARD OF ATHLETES NOT PARTICIPATING OR PARTICIPATING IN COMPETITION
- COACHES CANNOT MAKE DECISIONS ON ELIGIBILITY STANDARD WITHOUT PROPER APPROVAL THROUGH ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT
 - EXCEPTION: WHEN ASSOCIATED WITH INTERNAL TEAM EXPECTATIONS RELATED TO BEHAVIOR
 - ACADEMIC, ATTENDANCE, PAPERWORK, AND ANY OFFICIAL STATUS MUST BE CLEARED WITH ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT
- COACHES MUST CHECK ATTENDANCE AND LATENESS ON GAME DAYS
 - STUDENTS WHO ARE LATE OR ABSENT ON GAME OR EVENT DAY ARE AUTOMATICALLY INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE
 - EXCEPTION: DOCTORS NOTE OR EMERGENCY SITUATION THAT IS CLEARED AS VIABLE BY ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT
- PAPERWORK PROVIDED TO COACHES BUT NOT ENTERED INTO FINALFORMS IS NOT ASSOCIATED WITH CLEARED STATUS
- PARENT NOTE PROVIDING CONSENT FOR PARTICIPATION IS NOT CONSIDERED APPROPRIATE CLEARANCE
 - SYSTEMS ARE DESIGNED TO AVOID THESE SITUATIONS

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ELIGIBILITY

COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO BECOME FAMILIAR WITH ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS SPECIFIC TO THE LEAGUE THEY PARTICIPATE IN BUT MOST IMPORTANTLY INWOOD ACADEMY STUDENT-ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY.

WHILE DIFFERENT LEAGUE HAVE DIFFERENT STANDARDS, INWOOD ACADEMY ATHLETICS, IN MOST SITUATIONS, WILL HOLD STUDENTS TO A HIGHER STANDARD OF ACADEMIC, BEHAVIOR, AND ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS.

MAKE SURE TO ALWAYS HOLD STUDENT-ATHLETES TO THAT STANDARD. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH STUDENT-ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY WILL RESULT IN INCONSISTENCIES OF EXPECTATION BETWEEN TEAMS, CONSEQUENCES IMPOSED BY LEAGUES, AND POSSIBLE DISMISSAL OF COACHING DUTIES.

IF SOME EXPECTATIONS ARE NOT CLEAR OR REQUIRE CLARITY, PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION AND DO NOT ALLOW STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE AND RISK THE INTEGRITY OF THE SCHOOL AND YOURSELF AS A COACH.

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MIDDLE SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY

BELOW ARE THE BASIC ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS FOR STUDENT-ATHLETES AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL LEVEL.

MIDDLE SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS - BASICS

- STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN **90%** ATTENDANCE EACH SEMESTER
- STUDENT-ATHLETES AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL LEVEL MUST PASS ALL CLASSES AT EVERY RELEASE OF OFFICIAL ACADEMIC REPORT - MARKING PERIOD
- FAILURE TO PASS EVERY CLASS WILL RESULT IN ACTIVE INELIGIBLE STATUS
- STUDENTS ABSENT OR LATE TO SCHOOL ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION OR A GAME ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THAT GAME
- ONLY EXCEPTION IS DOCTORS NOTE THAT IS SUBMITTED OR EMERGENCY THAT IS DETERMINED BY ATHLETIC DEPARMENT AS A VIABLE EXCUSE

HIGH SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY

HIGH SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS - BASICS

- STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN **90%** ATTENDANCE EACH SEMESTER
- THE COURSE REQUIREMENT IS EXPLAINED WITH THE **5+1** RULE
 - 5 COURSES MUST BE PASSED EACH SEMESTER PLUS 1 WHICH IS PHYSICAL EDUCATION
 - OUT OF THE 5 COURSES, 3 MUST BE CORE SUBJECT MATTER
 - CORES SUBJECT CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING
 - ENGLISH - MATHEMATICS - SOCIAL STUDIES - SCIENCE - FOREIGN/WORLD LANGUAGE - AND/OR ANY MAJOR COURSE REQUIRING ATLEAST 2 YEAR SEQUENCE
- STUDENT MUST OBTAIN **10** CREDITS WITHIN 2 SEMESTERS TO REMAIN ELIGIBLE
 - P.E. IS CONSIDERED **.5** CREDITS AND NOT CALCULATED FOR THE 10 CREDIT MINIMUM
- STUDENTS ABSENT OR LATE TO SCHOOL ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION OR A GAME ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THAT GAME
 - ONLY EXCEPTION IS DOCTORS NOTE THAT IS SUBMITTED OR EMERGENCY THAT IS DETERMINED BY ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT AS A VIABLE EXCUSE

RESPONSIBILITIES BUILDING USAGE

THE FOLLOWING ARE LISTED EXPECTATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH USAGE OF THE FACILITIES AT INWOOD ACADEMY. SAFETY IS PRIORITY PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

- UPON ARRIVAL TO FACILITY THE COACH OR ATHLETIC PERSONNEL MUST BE THE ONLY INDIVIDUAL TO OPEN THE MAIN DOORS
- UPON DEPARTURE FROM THE BUILDING THE COACH MUST ENSURE NO STUDENT-ATHLETES REMAIN IN THE FACILITY
- ANY FORM OF KEY OR KEYCARD FOR ENTRY WITHIN DIFFERENT BUILDINGS MUST NOT AND CANNOT BE GIVEN TO A STUDENT-ATHLETE FOR USE
- COACHES MUST CHECK ALL AREAS UTILIZED BEFORE AND AFTER SESSIONS
 - EQUIPMENT ROOM MUST NOT BE LEFT IN DISORDER
- STUDENT-ATHLETES MUST NOT UTILIZE THE STAFF BATHROOMS ESPECIALLY DURING ACTIVE PROGRAMMING
- HOME EVENTS
 - COACH MUST MAINTAIN TEAM CONTROL
 - ON FLOOR, BENCH, MANAGERS, ETC.
 - MAINTAIN DISCIPLINE
 - UNDERSTAND EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN (EAP)
 - AVAILABLE ON WEBSITE

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RESPONSIBILITIES AWAY EVENTS

THE FOLLOWING ARE LISTED EXPECTATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH EVENTS THAT TAKE PLACE OUTSIDE OUR FACILITIES. THESE GAMES/EVENTS ARE FUN AND PROVIDE A VALUABLE ASPECT OF THE ATHLETIC EXPERIENCE BUT MUST BE WELL PLANNED AND EXECUTED. YOU AS THE COACH ARE FULLY AND LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE STUDENT, DURING AWAY CONTEST

- COACHES MUST PLAN ACCORDINGLY TO LEAVE EARLY FOR AWAY EVENTS
- ALL AWAY GAMES/EVENTS MUST BE COMMUNICATED WITH STUDENT-ATHLETES AND FAMILIES WELL IN ADVANCE
 - PROVIDING A SEASON SCHEDULE IS A KEY COMPONENT TO ENSURE NO SURPRISES
 - COMMUNICATION ON SPORTSYOU TO THE TEAM MUST BE DONE 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE AS A REMINDER OF THE UPCOMING EVENT
- STUDENT-ATHLETES MUST TRAVEL WITH APPROVED ADULT TO THE AWAY CONTEST
- STANDARD PROTOCOL IS TEAM TRAVELS TO THE EVENT TOGETHER AND BACK TO THE SCHOOL TOGETHER
- DISMISSAL FROM OUTSIDE DESTINATION AFTER THE EVENT MUST BE APPROVED BY PARENT COMMENT IN THE SPORTSYOU GAME POST
 - VERBAL APPROVAL IS NOT ALLOWED BY ANY MEANS
- ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE COUNTED PRIOR TO DEPARTURE AND PRIOR TO RETURN, ANYTHING MISSING MUST BE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY
