


1947 FOOTBALL, BASKETBALL, BASEBALL, TRACK

Was all SCVAL in football his senior season despite playing the first 5 games with a severe ankle sprain and missing the last 4 games after an emergency appendectomy
Was Football MVP his junior year gaining all SCVAL honors

Led the Varsity basketball team to three league titles playing center. Chosen all SCVAL Was baseball teams best pitcher and also played shortstop

Led the track team to the SCVAL championship throwing the Discus, Shot Put, and running the low hurdles

1958 FOOTBALL, BASKETBALL, BASEBALL, TRACK


Named All-League in Football both his junior and senior seasons as quarterback, halfback, and linebacker

Played 4 years of baseball as a pitcher and third baseman, although a broken ankle shortened both his track and baseball seasons his senior year

In track, he ran the sprints and was a high jumper, twice finishing 3rd in the SCVAL






1970 FOOTBALL, WRESTLING


FOOTBALL, BASKETBALL, BASEBALL






