

THE IRONMAN AWARD

In 1961 our former director Chester A. Wisniewski felt a distinctive award should be given to outstanding senior multi sport athletes. Fr chester established the award and called it the Ironman Award.

The first awards were presented at the 12th annual all sports dinner. Every year since 1961, the award has been presented to senior student athletes who have filed out an application with the Director of Athletics and have fulfilled the requirements set by Fr. Chester. At the completion of the 2017/2018 school year, the total Ironman honorees are 809. The requirements are as follows:

- Must have a cumulative average of 80% over his four years.
- He must have earned a minimum of two varsity letters during his four year career.
- The candidate must have been selected to a first or second team all state, all county or all league at least once in one of his two sports.
