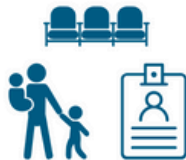
EVENT GUIDELINES

Guidelines Apply to all Norman Public Schools Events



Entry & Re-entry

- All attendees must enter through a weapons detection system
- No entry once ticket gates are closed
- Re-entry is not permitted. *Exception:* Tournaments and all-day events (e.g. track meets) may allow re-entry, must re-enter through weapons detection system



Student Expectations

- All middle and elementary students must be with a parent, guardian or chaperone for the entire event
- NPS middle and high school students must present a student ID to enter. NPS students get in free with a valid student badge with the exception of Crosstown Clash Events.
- Students must sit in the designated student section or with their parent/guardian
- No loitering
- The NPS Student Code of Conduct applies at all district events



Bag & Item Policy

- Clear plastic tote bags allowed (1 per person)
- Clear, unopened water bottles allowed (1 per person)
- Non-transparent clutch wallets allowed (max size: 4.5" x 6.5")
- Diaper bags and strollers permitted for family care
- Bags for approved medical equipment permitted
- All other bags/backpacks are not allowed



Prohibited Items

- Explosives, firearms, knives or weapons of any type
- All forms of tobacco, alcohol, drugs and vapes
- Bags, backpacks, fanny packs, hard binocular cases
- Balls or sporting equipment
- Coolers, containers, or outside food
- Laser pointers and noisemakers
- Pets (except registered service animals)

Violations may result in removal from the event and/or loss of future event privileges.

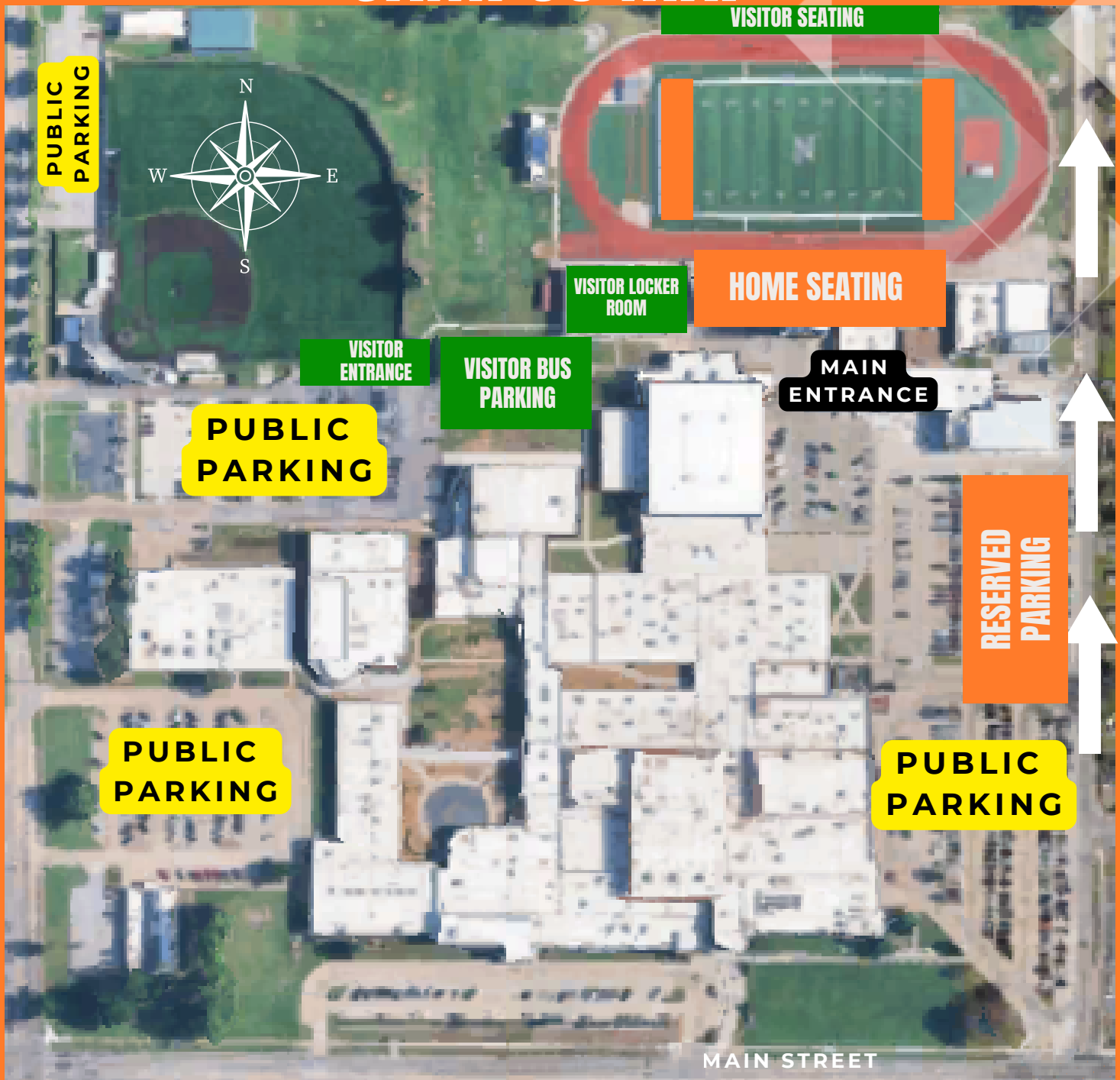

INCLEMENT WEATHER PROTOCOL

In the event of inclement weather during outside activity, the following information listed below is to assist with the suspension of game procedures and also evacuation plans for fans and spectators.

- Authority for starting a contest rests with the Home Administration.
- The sole authority for play interruption after the contest begins rests with Lead Official along with communication from Game Administration
- A collaborative effort should be made by the Administration from Both Schools and Officials in regards to the decision-making process
- Termination and/or rescheduling must be agreed by Both Schools

Inclement Weather Procedures

- NPS will use the program "Perry Weather" system to monitor storms that contain inclement weather along with access to radar
- The individual(s) who are alerted from these programs that inclement weather is near will use the following criteria along with input from school administration and game officials:
- Lightning within a 10-mile radius of the event will postpone/suspend the contest
- The contest will continue to be suspended or postponed for 30 minutes after each lightning strike is recorded in a 10-mile radius
- Contest will resume once no lightning strikes have occurred in a 10-mile radius for 30 minutes

Evacuation Plan for Harve Collins

- All teams escorted to their locker-rooms
- All officials escorted to their locker-rooms
- Spectators will be notified that NHS Gymnasium (east/west hallways)/storm shelter will be opened for access and be used if needed
- All spectators must leave the facility
- Spectators who wish to leave the facility using their own vehicle may do so



EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

IN AN EMERGENCY DIAL 9-911 OR 911 BY MOBILE PHONE

Medical Administrator: RYAN JACOBS/LAUREN HOUSTON/TIM HIGHTOWER or Site Administration

Emergency Personnel: Certified Athletic Trainer, Student Athletic Trainers, Coaches, Administrators

Emergency Equipment: AED, splint kit, spine board all located in the Defensive Staff Room in the Gene Corroto Building.

Emergency Communication: Fixed telephone in the training room, Football office, or use available mobile phone

Medical and School Official Responsibilities:

- Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
- Emergency equipment retrieval
- Summon emergency medical services
- Control the scene: limit scene to emergency personnel, move bystanders from area
- Notify Certified Athletic Trainer and main office

If an emergency occurs, the Emergency Management Coordinator must be notified as soon as practical

To call an ambulance: Call 9-911 from a fixed phone or 911 from a mobile phone. Provide name, location, phone number, number of individuals injured, condition of the injured, care administered, specific directions, other info as requested.
