QUICK HITTERS – FAQ Info for Visiting teams

• Where do we park our bus? (page 4)







Women's Coaching Staff





Head coach Kyle Axton is in his 3rd year at the helm of the Lady Wolves basketball program. The ladies finished last year with a record of 15-11. Axton's team defeated Moore and Deer Creek in the 6A Regionals and advanced to the Area bracket–where they lost in the first round. Several starters graduated from last year's team, but there is still a good core of seniors, along with some young sophomores and freshmen, who will fill those holes in the offense and defense line-ups.

Axton has been coaching for 18 years and comes to Santa Fe from Calumet High School... a Class A girls program in Oklahoma. While at Calumet, his teams made 2 appearances in the State Tournament... 2016 and 2020. Prior to his time at Calumet, Axton was at Ft. Towson for 4 years and Roxton, TX for 2 years.

Coach Axton is originally from Battiest, OK where he played basketball for 4 years in high school and graduated in 2003. He then attended Carl Albert State college and then went on to Southeastern Oklahoma State University, earning his Bachelors in 2007.

Coach Axton comes from a very athletic background. He has 4 siblings and 11 nieces & nephews.

Coach Naff is in her second year as an assistant coach this year at Santa Fe. She teaches Science and was previously an assistant coach at Putnam City High School.

Coach Lallemand is entering his 6th year at Santa Fe and has reached the state tournament in 2 of the last 4 seasons, which includes a State Semi-Final in 2022.

Prior to coming to Santa Fe, he was part of a staff that helped led Edmond Memorial to a combined 42-14 record and 2 State Tournament appearances during the 2018 and 2019 seasons. Before Memorial, Coach Lallemand spent 2 seasons as the Head Coach at Piedmont High School. The season prior to his time at Piedmont, he served as an assistant coach at Bixby High School, spent 4 years as an assistant coach at Kapaun Mount Carmel Catholic High School (Wichita, Kansas) and the next 4 seasons as the Head Boys' Varsity Basketball Coach in Winfield, Kansas. As the Head Coach in Winfield, he helped the Vikings to the 2nd best 4 year start in the previous 41 seasons.

Coach Lallemand attended Missouri Southern State University (Joplin, Missouri) where he was a member of the Lions baseball team. In 2005, he received his BSE in Kinesiology. Coach Lallemand attended high school in Girard, Kansas, where he was a 4A All-State performer in both football and basketball.

Coach Lallemand currently teaches in the PE Department at Santa Fe and resides in Edmond with his wife Megan and their beautiful daughter Blakely.



Tim Campbell - Assistant coach

Coach Campbell is new to the staff at Santa Fe this year. He was born and raised in Spencer, OK and attended Mount St. Marry High School where he played for former Santa Fe coach Lenny Hatchett. He is a graduate of UCO and is in his 13th year of coaching. He has spent time coaching in the Mid-Del school system and comes to Santa Fe after spending the last 8 years at Yukon High School.

Emergency Action Plan



A SERIOUS INJURY IS ANY CONDITION WHEREBY THE ATHLETE'S LIFE MAY BE IN DANGER OR RISKS PERMANENT IMPAIRMENT. THESE INJURIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: CERVICAL SPINE INJURIES, HEAD INJURIES, LOSS OF LIMB, SERIOUS BLEEDING, SHOCK, SERIOUS FRACTURES, HEAT STRESS AND CARDIOVASCULAR ARREST.

Purpose: To provide Edmond Santa Fe High School Athletics with an emergency action plan (EAP) in case of a serious or life-threatening condition that arises during practice or competitions. AT, coaches, and others involved in athletics must constantly be on guard for potential injuries, and although the occurrence of limb-threatening or life-threatening emergencies is not common, the potential exists. Therefore, prepared emergency responders must have planned in advance for the action to be taken in the event of such an emergency.

Information to be provided over the phone in case of emergency:

- 1. Name and phone number you are calling from.
- 2. Exact location of emergency and directions (street names, buildings, landmarks, entry into buildings, specific areas, etc.)
- 3. Type of injury or illness.
- 4. Condition of patient(s) and type of aid being provided.
- 5. Number of people injured.
- 6. Other information as requested and be the last one to hang up.

NO CONTACT WITH MEDIA from the Athletic Training Staff, Hospital Staff, Emergency Medical Personnel or Coaching Staff except through the Edmond Santa Fe Athletic Department.

- Establish a hospital contact person.
- Meeting with athletes to discuss situation

NO OUTSIDE DISCUSSION OF MEETING WITH MEDIA

- Complete documentation of events: include everyone involved with signatures.
- Collect and secure all equipment and materials involved.
- Construct a detailed timeline of events related to the incident.
- Involve appropriate counseling personnel.
- Assign athletic staff members to be with family at all times upon arrival; assist family as needed; protect from outside persons.
- Critical incident stress debriefing/counseling as necessary for individuals involved in the incident.
