Coach Lallemand is entering his 4th year at Santa Fe, Santa Fe has reached the last 2 state tournaments, including the State Semi-Final last season.

Prior to coming to Santa Fe, he was part of a staff that helped lead Edmond Memorial to a combined 42-14 record and 2 State Tournament appearances during the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

Before Memorial, Coach Lallemand spent 2 seasons as the Head Coach at Piedmont High School. The season prior to his time at Piedmont, he served as an assistant coach at Bixby High School, spent 4 years as an assistant coach at Kapaun Mount Carmel Catholic High School (Wichita, Kansas) and the next 4 seasons as the Head Boys' Varsity Basketball Coach in Winfield, Kansas. As the Head Coach in Winfield, he helped the Vikings to the 2nd best 4 year start in the previous 41 seasons.

Prior to entering the teaching and coaching profession, Coach Lallemand attended Missouri Southern State University (Joplin, Missouri) where he was a member of the Lions baseball team. In 2005, he received his BSE in Kinesiology. Coach Lallemand attended high school in Girard, Kansas, where he was a 4A All-State performer in both football and basketball. Coach Lallemand currently teaches in the Physical Education Department at Santa Fe and resides in Edmond with his wife Megan and their beautiful daughter Blakely.






