EMERGENCY PLAN

Life threatening injury

- Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will administer appropriate care to injured athlete until EMS arrives.
- ATC will ask individual to find Athletic Director/Game Manager who will notify campus police, and will radio for EMS.
- EMS will meet Campus Police on "B" street and will escort them in.



Non-Life threatening Injury

- ATC will administer appropriate care to injured athlete until parents/guardians have arrived.
- Parents/guardians will be given instructions to nearest healthcare facility.
- If parents/guardians cannot be reached, emergency contact will be contacted.

SEVERE WEATHER / NATURAL DISASTER

All stands will be cleared by Athletic Director/Game Manager. Spectators will not be allowed back in until the all clear is given by A.D./Game Manager. Both teams will take shelter in their locker rooms., or on bus.



Activate the EAP

• Any loss of consciousness	• Difficulty or absent breathing or pulse

Emergency Procedures-*IDENTIFY ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR EACH SPORT AND VENUE YEARLY*

1. **INDIVIDUAL #1** Check the Scene
 - a. Is it safe for you to help?
 - b. What happened?
 - c. How many victims are there?
 - d. Can bystanders help?
2. Identify severity of injury and potential diagnoses
 - a. Check circulation/airway/breathing (CAB), level of consciousness, and severe bleeding
3. Instruct **INDIVIDUAL #2** to call 911, provide the following information
 - a. Who you are, General information about the injury or situation
 - b. Where you are (Provide: name, location of downed patient, address, telephone #, number of individuals injured, type of injury that has occurred, treatment given, specific directions*)

4. **INDIVIDUAL #1** Perform emergency care (including CPR, AED application, First Aid, Cooling, etc.)
5. Instruct **INDIVIDUAL #3** to get the relevant emergency equipment (i.e., AED, heat stress emergency kit, prepare cold tub, glucose, first aid supplies, emergency kit)
6. Designate **INDIVIDUAL #5** to control crowd
7. **INDIVIDUAL #7**-Contact the AT for Jenks Public Schools if not present on scene.
 - a. Contact Parent/Guardian
 - b. Contact Athletic Director
8. Instruct **INDIVIDUALS** to meet ambulance and direct to appropriate site
 - a. **INDIVIDUAL #4**-Open Appropriate Gates/Doors
 - b. **INDIVIDUAL #6**-This individual will "flag down" and direct to scene
9. Assist qualified health professional providing care, EMS and/or other personnel with care as directed
10. **INDIVIDUAL #8** will accompany the patient to the hospital or follow in a care if not allowed in ambulance


Jenks Public Schools Central Campus Map


