FIELDHOUSE: Located on S.E. 23rd between 15th and 29th streets in Midwest City. Park in the East Parking Lot, unless school hours are in session, then park in the South parking lot.

ADMISSION: See additional attachment.

FIELDHOUSE LOBBY: Unattended children are not allowed to run, play games, or bounce any type of balls in this area. Children should never be unattended. Restrooms are located in the lobby. Please refrain from watching the matches from the lobby area window. Concessions are available. NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED.

FANS: Please park in the east parking when available. The south parking lot is available at all times. All fans are asked to sit in the bleachers or seats above the court floor. Fans will refrain from visiting athletes on the court after the events. Patrons are not allowed to sit on the court floor. Persons displaying egregious acts will be escorted from the event by uniformed police. Please do not linger in the Fieldhouse lobby. Clear Bag Policy will be in place. Every attendee will walk through our weapon detection system. There will be no re-entrance to events. Once you enter, if you exit you may not re-enter. We will close the gate at the start of the third quarter and no more entrees will be allowed. Persons picking up students will be asked to wait outside in the parking lot.

NOISEMAKERS: For indoor activities: Any type of device that plays music, sounds, or voices, and noise makers of any kind such as air horns, cow bells, etc. will not be allowed to function/operate. This will also apply to pre-game/contest and post-game contest activities. This rule applies to both regular and post-season games/contest.

2024-2025 SPECTATOR PROCEDURES

If you leave during a varsity event, you will not be allowed to RE-ENTER the event once the varsity event begins.

Student Access to Events:

Students will NOT be allowed to crossover from designated seating. Fans must remain in designated areas.

Middle and High School Students from both participating schools must have an ID and it must be worn at ALL times at the event to attend. Ineligible students may not enter events.

If the visiting school does not have student IDs, an administrator for the visiting school must be onsite to approve entry of the visiting students.

Middle School and Elementary School students must have a guardian present and be seated with the guardian for the duration of the event.

Prohibited Items:

- Explosives, firearms, or weapons
- Alcohol (in all forms)
- No outside food or drink (with the exception of a clear water bottle). No tumblers or cups of any kind.
- Bags, backpacks, fanny packs & hard binocular cases (ONLY clear bags allowable)
- Balloons (unless it is part of a school sponsored ceremony)
- Beach balls, footballs, balls, or other sporting equipment
- Coolers, containers, or ice chests
- Laser pointers
- Pets (with the exception of registered service animals)
- Mid-Del campuses are Tobacco Free

NO FIREARMS, WEAPONS, OR EXPLOSIVES ALLOWED ON MID-DEL SCHOOL CAMPUSES.

Oklahoma prohibits possession of a firearm on any public or private school property.

*Ticket sales will end at the end of halftime. When ticket sales end, no one will be allowed re-entry into the event.



Bag Policy:

- No bags permitted unless it is a clear plastic tote bag (1 per person)
- Non-transparent clutch wallets no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" (1 per person)
- Bags necessary for approved medical equipment
- Approved family care items (diapers, formula, etc.) must be included in the clear plastic tote bag

Weapon Detection System:

Every attendee (including ALL Mid-Del staff) will walk through our weapon detection system at our large events. We will have security at our gates as well as multiple law enforcement officers at the event.
