- Admission:** Go Fan Tickets are available on the home page of OSSAA.com.
Cash tickets at the gate are \$10. All school age children grades K-12 will require a ticket.
Doors open at 5:00 p.m. Thursday and Friday, and 2:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday.
- Accepted Passes:** The passes below are accepted at the gate, please be prepared to present a photo ID if asked.
OSSAA- pass holder only
Varsity Spirit Teams in uniform
- Code of Conduct:** Make sportsmanship a priority for students, parents, fans, coaches, and athletes.
Security and Administration are available for those unable to display good sportsmanship.
- Bus Parking:** School is dismissed at 3:37 p.m.: from 3:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. traffic will be extremely busy and very slow (we strongly suggest planning your arrival for before 3:30pm or after 4:00pm).
Team buses will unload on the WEST side of the UMAC, and park against the fence that borders the Sam's parking lot (south edge of the parking lot).

OSSAA Info: Bench decorum- Assistant Coaches are not authorized to approach the scorer's table at any time after the start of the contest. The Head Coach is permitted to go the table to request a time out or to confer with personnel regarding a correctable error, to prevent or rectify a timing or scorer error or an alternating possession error. Assistant Coaches and bench personnel must remain seated during live ball play. There seems to be a growing trend for bench personnel to stand until the team scores, this is not permitted by NFHS rule. Assistant Coaches and bench personnel may stand during a time-out or to celebrate a great play.

Head Coaches are required to stay inside the coach's box, you may not coach outside the designated box at any time during live ball play. Coaches should not enter the playing area except for during a time out.

Shirt tails **MUST** be tucked in while the player is in the contest. No more than one logo is permitted on undershirts, arm sleeves, leg sleeves, tights, head bands, wrist bands etc. If there is more than one logo, the item is not permitted.

Head Coaches are responsible to maintain good sportsmanship for each person on the team, including Assistant Coaches and players and other personnel. The game officials are reporting an increase in profanity from players. The use of profanity is never acceptable in education-based activities. Please remind your players.

The OSSAA basketball manual does not allow anyone other than those participating in the contest to warm up during the intermission between halves

(OSSAA Basketball Manual: XVII-B)- Warm-ups- Players, except the participants of the game, shall not be permitted to warm up at half time in regular season as well as play-offs.

Rules of Notice: No backpacks, other than those used by the teams and spirit teams. Bags are subject to search. **No signs, banners, or flags by students/fans.** Cheerleaders may hold up small signs or letters. Fat-heads are allowed if in good taste.

Student ID: Students in the 9th -12th grades will be required to show their student ID. Students 8th grade and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

Home Team Fans: Sections 101-109 & 119-126 on the NORTH, SOUTH and EAST sides of the arena are for the home team fans.

Home Spirit Teams: The NORTH baseline is for the home spirit teams.

Home Students: Sections 107-108 on the NORTH end of the arena is for the home team students.

Visiting Fans: Sections 110-118 on the EAST side of the arena is for visiting fans.

Visiting Spirit Teams: The SOUTH baseline of the arena is for visiting spirit teams.

Visiting Students: Section 115 on the EAST side of the arena is for visiting students.

UNION ATHLETIC TRAINING Medical Emergency Action Plan

SPORT: UMAC

YEAR: 2026

ADDRESS: 6836 SOUTH MINGO RD

1. First to arrive on scene provides initial care.
2. Send for AED.
 - ✓ Location: **Arena-north wall; 2nd floor-west wall; on floor w/Athletic Trainer**
3. Send a coach, manager, or uninjured student-athlete to notify the athletic trainer (ATC) if not on site.
4. If the ATC cannot be located, the head coach will become the leader.

LEADER:

- This person will be in charge of the emergency and will instruct others on the emergency team accordingly.

LEADER'S ASSISTANT:

- Will assist the leader in the primary evaluation of the injured athlete.

PHONE CALLER (there should be designated adult to carry a phone):

- Will use the nearest phone to activate EMS
- Information to be communicated to EMS
 - The nature of injury
 - Level of consciousness
 - Age / sex of injured
- Caller will not hang up until EMS operator advises to do so.

PERSON TO MEET EMS:

- Ambulance entrance: **LOADING DOCK, southeast corner of UMAC**
- Will contact necessary staff to assure full access for ambulance
- Will meet ambulance at the designated entrance and lead to injured athlete

PERSON TO ACCOMPANY ATHLETE TO HOSPITAL:

- Will ride with the athlete in the ambulance in the event the parent / guardian cannot be contacted
- Will have athletes physical and emergency information in hand.

It is the ATC's responsibility to inform Athletic Director of the incident.

It is the ATC's or head coach's responsibility to inform athlete's parent / guardian.

It is the ATC's responsibility to document incident and all actions taken.
