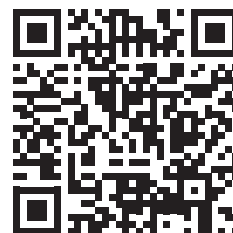

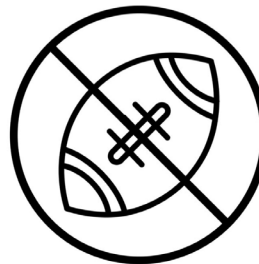

NOTE: There will be Reserved Parking spaces requiring a permit in the parking lot north of the stadium end zone (Boosters). There will be non-reserved spaces available further east within the northern lot and the lot will be closed once the non reserved spaces are filled. The eastern gate off of Pine Oak will be closed and attended. It will reopen at kickoff.

Those parking in the newest lot (the smaller limited parking lot between the two houses on Pine Oak) will need to walk out onto Pine Oak, south towards Scott St and up towards the stadium. Those parking in the larger Pine Oak parking lot, their path is toward the north end of the stadium and around to the front.

IN AN EMERGENCY DIAL 8-911 or 911 BY MOBILE PHONE

Medical Administrator: Stephannie Woodruff (405)747-0152

Emergency Personnel: AMR (Present for Varsity Home Games; Located in the Southeast corner of the Stadium)

Emergency Equipment:

AED/Splint Bag will be present with the Certified Athletic Trainer on the sideline. An additional AED will be located just inside the Soccer Facility at the South End of the Field.

Emergency Communication:

Fixed telephone in the Weight Room, Football Office, Soccer Office or available mobile phone.

Medical and School Official Responsibilities:

- Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
- Emergency equipment retrieval
- Summon emergency medical services
- Control the scene: limit scene to emergency personnel, move bystanders from area
- Notify Certified Athletic Trainer and main office

If an emergency has occurred, the emergency management coordinator must be notified as soon as practical.

To call an ambulance:

Call 8-911 from a fixed phone or 911 from a mobile phone. Provide name, location, phone number; number of individuals injured, condition of the injured, care administered, specific directions, other info as requested. Emergency Personnel will make Hospital Recommendations based on the Condition of the patient.
